Yufeng Shen received the Ph.D. in chemistry from Brigham Young University, Provo, Utah, in 1998. Prior to this he attended the Chinese Academy of Sciences, Dalian Institute of Chemical Physics, China. He joined the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, Richland, WA, in 2000, and is currently a Scientist V in the Biological Systems Analysis and Mass Spectrometry Group (with Dr. Richard D. Smith). His research focuses on new MS peptide/protein identification methodology with improved specificity and extending chromatography to large polypeptides (including intact proteins).

Prior to this, he held the positions of Scientist IV and Scientist III with the Biological Systems Analysis and Mass Spectrometry Group.

He has authored or co-authored 91 peer reviewed articles and has given numerous invited presentations.
