Harold McNair

Harold M. McNair, Professor Emeritus, Department of Chemistry, Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, has been active in the field of chromatography for over 50 years. He is one of the pioneers of gas chromatography and has continued to produce relevant research, as demonstrated by his publication list and also by his work as an instructor for many short courses in ACS National Meetings and the Pittsburgh Conference. He has also devoted a great deal of time and effort to encouraging the development of the separation sciences in Latin America and other areas of the world. He has published over 100 peer-reviewed articles on chromatography, and his awards include the EAS Award for Analytical Chemistry; the Horvath Medal from the Connecticut Separation Science Council; the Dal Nogare Award from the Pittsburgh Conference; the Award in Chromatography from the Chicago Chromatography Discussion Group; the Tswett Medal in Chromatography from the Russian Academy of Sciences; and the K.P. Dimick Award in Chromatography.
