

U4'S LOGICAL FRAMEWORK FOR 2022–2026

Impact: The damaging effect of corruption on a just and equitable future for all has been reduced.

Long-term outcome (0.0.1 to 0.0.2): U4's work (our high-quality research and tailored evidence-based resources, eg courses) have improved the understanding of corruption and support our partners – and the wider development community – efforts in countering it.

1. RESEARCH

Intermediate outcome 1 (1.0.1 to 1.0.4): Practitioners and other key stakeholders that have read U4 publications and/or research have a better understanding of anti- corruption issues and approaches.

Outputs 1.1 (1.1.1 to 1.1.4): Knowledge on anti- corruption practice and policy is produced and promoted, including accessing the U4 website.

2. CAPACITY BUILDING

Intermediate outcome 2 (2.0.1 to 2.0.4): Practitioners and other key stakeholders that have taken a U4 online course or attended an in- country workshop have a better understanding of anti- corruption issues and approaches.
