CALL 911

if you're having heart attack or stroke symptoms

HEART ATTACK SYMPTOMS:



Chest pain



Difficulty breathing



Discomfort in chest, arms, back, neck, shoulder or jaw

STROKE SYMPTOMS:



Numbness, weakness or loss of movement in your face, leg or arm, especially on one side



Confusion, trouble speaking or understanding



Loss of balance

ER

Emergency injuries such as: seizure, severe bleeding, head injuries, broken bones

In-person visits

URGENT CARE

Treat minor illnesses or injuries that are not emergencies such as: sinus symptoms, sprains, fever, rash, allergies and earaches

In-person and virtual visits

PRIMARY CARE

Support your health with: required shots, wellness exams, health screenings, chronic disease management (diabetes, high blood pressure, asthma)
