Fotografiska Berlin

Fotografiska Berlin is the fourth museum in the Fotografiska group, following Stockholm, Tallin, and New York. As the contemporary museum of photography, art, and culture, we are proudly committed to showcasing cutting-edge artistic talent from both near and far, and to honoring the history of both our building and our community.

Current Exhibitions

Our current exhibitions explore the power of photography with work from artists across the globe. Each of the three exhibitions offers a unique viewpoint, pushing the boundaries of visual storytelling and spanning a range of formats and approaches.

After The Party reveals a different side to Andy Warhol; an individual longing to belong, captured through his camera lens. Each photograph tells a story around his desire to engage with fellow revelers, lovers, and confidants. With rarely seen intimate photographs, you're invited to experience his search for connection.

In *Un/Masked*, artist Elizaveta Porodina invites us to peer behind our masks, holding up a mirror to ourselves. Her abstract and surrealist photographs, in the interplay of light, color, and shadow, also reflect her inner world: "I grant my audience a window into my subconscious with my work."

In *Futuristic Ancestry*, artist Josèfa Ntjam explores collective histories, as well as her own memories, to deconstruct dominant narratives and uncover a new, liberated future through images of African mythologies, ancestral rituals, Cameroonian independence movements, and freedom fighters such as the Black Panthers.

In *WE WILL SLAM YOU WITH OUR WINGS*, Joanna Dudley presents a transformative narrative: six girls, ages eight to 16, challenge the tragic fates of women in operatic arias, such as Dido, Tosca, Madame Butterfly and Salome, turning them from victims to heroines.

In *Triple Seven*, Anne Lass works with still life and portraits to track down gambling halls in Berlin, which are often a closed universe in themselves, and have now mostly disappeared. The exhibition is part of our talent program *Emerging Berlin*.
