Fotografiska Berlin

Fotografiska Berlin inspires new perspectives through thought-provoking photography, world-class food and beverage experiences, and engaging dialogues with local and global communities. We offer a carefully curated program of ongoing exhibitions and special events spread across our 5,500-square-meter museum in the heart of Berlin's Mitte district, and we are open to visitors 365 days a year.

Fotografiska Berlin is the fourth museum in the Fotografiska group, following Stockholm, Tallin, and New York. As the contemporary museum of photography, art, and culture, we are proudly committed to showcasing cutting-edge artistic talent from both near and far, and to honoring the history of both our building and our community.

Current Exhibitions

Our current exhibitions explore the power of photography with work from artists across the globe. Each of the three exhibitions offers a unique viewpoint, pushing the boundaries of visual storytelling and spanning a range of formats and approaches.

These exhibitions are at the vanguard of today's discourses around art and identity. In Juliana Huxtable's show *-USSYPHILIA*, the artist presents a site-specific body of work alongside pieces from her *AKIMBO-SPITTLE* series. Together, the show confronts contemporary discourses around identity and how it is formed. In *Whiteface*, artist Candice Breitz pairs video work with found audio footage to explore whiteness and race.

Fotografiska Berlin is also home to *NUDE*, a Fotografiska international show featuring the work of 30 different female-identifying artists from 20 countries, each challenging traditional constructs around body politics, and the histories that shaped them.
