

Executive Education Campus Guidelines: Pre-Arrival/Campus Access



1. Access to Campus:

In order to gain access to our campus, you must be able to present one of the following certificates daily:

- Proof of booster vaccination (three vaccinations in total)
- Proof of recent 2nd vaccination (earliest after 14 days and not older than 90 days)
- Proof of at least one vaccination plus certificate of recovery.

You must show a negative official COVID-19 rapid test (not older than 24h), or a negative PCR-test (not older than 24h), if:

- You have a certificate of a 2nd vaccination, which is older than 90 days.



2. Traveling to Germany from abroad?

Germany's travel restrictions & guidelines are frequently being updated. It is your responsibility to be informed prior to your departure. Face Masks:

- A face mask (surgical mask, FFP2 or KN95) must be worn at all times while being on campus.

Social Distancing & Catering:

- Please keep the social distancing guidelines in mind while on campus. Unless it is otherwise indicated, please keep a suggested minimum distance of 1.5 m between yourself and others.
- When applicable, please pay attention to the one-way system and follow the marked pathways for entering and leaving the premises.
- Lunches, refreshments and snacks will be provided in closed / wrapped single portions or buffet style.

Hand Sanitizer & Disinfection Practices:

- All facilities on campus will be regularly disinfected and cleaned.
- Fresh air circulation will be ensured in all rooms regularly. Please bring a sweater or a jacket as temperatures may vary.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers have been placed throughout both campuses. Please disinfect your hands upon arrival on campus and before entering the catering areas.

Campus Facilities:

- Room capacities of our lecture halls are highly monitored to ensure that all participants are safe.
