Our commitment to achieving Net Zero

ThreeTenSeven is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2030. Through the process of becoming a B Corp, we have already made significant strides in reducing our emissions through myriad reduction activities, even before our baseline was measured. By 2030 we will have achieved Net Zero status, well ahead of the UK's 2050 deadline.

1: Our baseline carbon emissions

Baseline year: 2023	
Additional details relating to the baseline emissions calculations.	
<p>This is our first Carbon Reduction Plan so in this document we are establishing our baseline. Significant reductions have already been made before baseline assessment took place.</p> <p>Our baseline Scope 1 and 2 emissions baseline were assessed using an on-site audit from Green Gain environmental consultancy (08.02.24) via West Yorkshire Combined Authority, and separately using the Net Zero Carbon Supplier Tool (December 2023). Green Gain's report showed significantly more carbon usage and as this was the more robust auditing process, we have used this as our benchmark.</p> <p>We had no previous Scope 3 emissions reporting, so for the purpose of this report, our baseline Scope 3 emissions are taken from 2023, the full calendar year, using the LNER calculator.</p>

2: Our targets for reducing emissions

To achieve Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

1. To achieve a reduction in our total carbon emissions in 2025.

2. To achieve Net Zero by 2030.

3: Completed carbon reduction initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented before we established our baseline:

- Moved to eco-friendly energy supplier
- Removed paper record-keeping
- Reduced printing
- Installing LED lighting
- Introducing a Cycle to Work scheme to encourage active travel
- Produced helpful employee guide on efficient energy use at home
- Improved recycling facilities on site, reduced all waste, etc

In the future we will implement further measures such as:

- Introducing further energy-saving behaviours across the business
- Discouraging use of single-occupant cars
- Encouraging use of public transport, car-sharing and active travel
- Adopt certified/verified carbon offsetting measures

These measures will be in effect when performing all contracts.

4: Declaration and sign-off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting².

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard³.
