
The good news is that, at this moment, every human being is far more connected to their fellow humans than any human has ever been in the entirety of recorded history.

Please treat this discussion forum with the same respect you would a public park. We, too, are a shared community resource — a place to share skills, knowledge and interests through ongoing conversation.



Laboratory studies show that this kind of force-feeding can activate bias rather than stamp it out.

As social scientists have found, people often rebel against rules to assert their autonomy. Try to coerce me to do X, Y, or Z, and I'll do the opposite just to prove that I'm my own person.

In one study white subjects read a brochure critiquing prejudice toward blacks.

When people felt pressure to agree with it, the reading strengthened their bias against blacks.

When they felt the **choice** was theirs, the reading **reduced** bias.
