

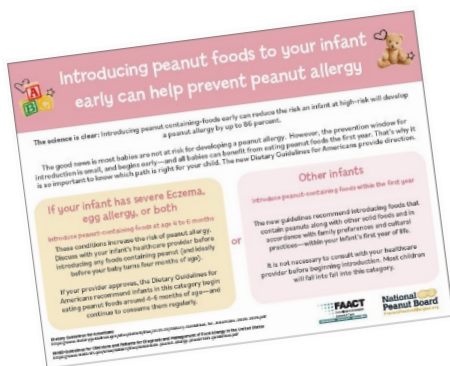
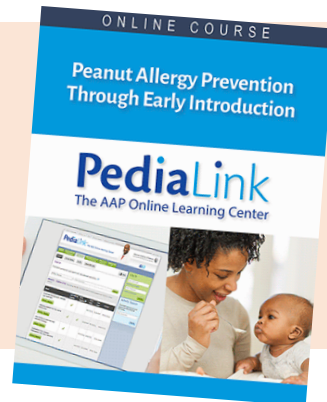
Introducing peanut foods to infants as early as 4-6 months of age can help prevent peanut allergies and the lifetime of burdens they bring

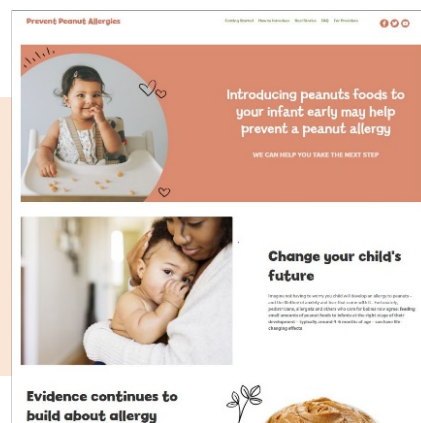
