Local Access to Facilities

The centre closes to the public on the **10 July**. This is due to the essential works required to have the venue ready to host the World Championships.

The golf course will still be available for the general public to use, however the car park will be out of commission from 10th July to 21st August.

All golfers will check in to a temporary structure at the first T as the main venue will be temporarily closed.

Regular users of the golf course and those making bookings will be advised at the time of booking of any changes to accessing the golf course/ parking restrictions.

Noise

There will be general noise associated with venue build as well as some noise from some vehicle movement prior to the event days. During the event there will also be background music and general commentator noise via the in-house PA system. The start gate at the beginning of each race (which drops to let the bikes descend the ramp) will be more frequent during the event than during normal operating times.



Traffic & Travel

Parking Restrictions

2 August 2023 - 13 August 2023

The temporary parking restriction should have minimum impact on residential parking, the restrictions are being implemented to ensure roads adjacent to the venue are not subjected to obstructive parking therefore ensuring access for the community and emergency service vehicles.

The following roads will be impacted:

- Archerhill Road (both sides) between Clarion Road and Lincoln Avenue
- Lincoln Avenue (both sides) between
 Loanfoot Avenue and Archerhill Road
- Loanfoot Avenue (northside) between Lincoln Avenue and Clarion Road
- Waldemar Road (westside) between Archerhill Road and Chaplet Avenue



Parking enforcement will be carried out to support the temporary measures.

Road Closures

3 August 2023 – 13 August 2023: Archerhill Road between Clarion Road and Waldemar Road

3 August 2023 – 9 August 2023: Lincoln Avenue between Loanfoot Avenue and Archerhill Road

The road closures are being implemented as part of the venue transport plan to manage the athlete and other client groups access and egressing the venue in a safe and controlled manor. This plan aims to minimise disruption to the local area while still making sure the event can run as intended and safely.

The closure of Archerhill Road is to support the safe delivery of both the Challenge Event and Elite competition.

The closure of Lincoln Avenue is to support the safe delivery of the Challenge Event only.

The road closure will remain in place throughout the period to support the safe delivery of the venue.

Spectators

Spectators are being strongly encouraged to use public transport or active travel to get to the venue. However, the local area will be monitored for parking issues and any parking illegally, blocking driveways etc. should be reported to the Police directly by calling 101.
