About Leicester Print Workshop

LPW promotes fine art printmaking through the provision of specialist knowledge and facilities, education and exhibitions.

We are supported by Arts Council England and our registered charity number is 1025337.

Getting to the Workshop

Leicester Print Workshop is in the Cultural Quarter, in Leicester City Centre. The workshop is on the corner of St George Street and Queen Street. We are in easy walking distance from Leicester Railway Station (0.5 miles, 10 min walk), Haymarket Bus Station (0.6 miles, 11 min walk) and St. Margaret's Bus Station (0.7 miles, 12 min walk).

Parking

We have a small car park for up to 7 cars on a first come first serve basis.

There is a selection of on-street parking available around the workshop in which you can park Monday – Saturday for up to three hours. Parking is free on Sundays and with a blue badge.

There are also plenty of nearby car parks including privately-operated car parks on Queen Street and Southampton Street, and the NCP car park on Halford Street (next to Curve).

Access

Our studio is on the ground floor and is fully accessible to wheelchair users. Please discuss with us ahead of your visit if you have any particular access needs.

General Information

Tea and coffee is available in the workshop kitchen, please make a donation for your refreshments. Please bring lunch with you; alternatively, there are a range of shops and cafes within a 10-minute walk of the Workshop.

Please bring a folder with you to take your prints home, if you don't have one we can supply newsprint and tissue to create a temporary one.

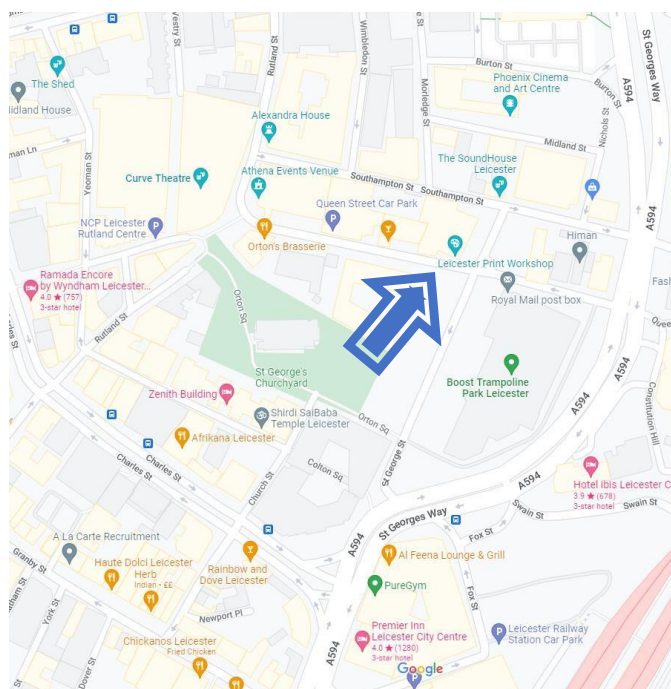

Becoming a member of Leicester Print Workshop

LPW members can use the studio during open access times: Wednesday – Saturday 10am – 5pm. You can become a member if you are competent in your chosen technique.

All new members must attend an induction. This is a three hour supervised printmaking session where members are able to familiarise themselves with the working environment of the workshop, with the guidance and support of a technician; the induction includes a health and safety briefing. There is a charge of £20 for the induction.

The next step is to request and complete an application form, available from the Leicester Print Workshop team.
