## BACKGROUND

The joint National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) and the International AIDS Society (IAS) research fellowship focuses on the linkages between HIV and drug use, with the specific goal of contributing to advances in the scientific understanding of HIV and drug use.

Each fellow works in collaboration with a highly experienced mentor at leading research institutes that have track records in HIV and drug use research. The fellowship programme aims at providing appropriate skills to ensure that researchers can apply the knowledge gained during the training opportunities to enhance future prevention and/or treatment of HIV-related drug use.

## ELIGIBILITY

This fellowship programme consists of two types of awards worth USD 75,000 aimed at:

-  A junior scientist with a doctoral degree (e.g. PhD, MD) for 18-months post-doctoral training
-  A well-established HIV researcher, not currently involved in HIV-related drug use research, for an eight-month long professional development training.
