







Side Event at the 59th Commission on Narcotic Drugs

Harm Reduction and the UNGASS: Feedback from the Expert Group Meeting in Berlin

Tuesday, 15 March, 2.20-3.10 p.m. in Conference Room M3

In February 2016 the hosts of this side event jointly organized an Expert Group Meeting on new approaches to harm reduction in Berlin. Representatives from 14 countries, as well as various civil society organisations and UN Agencies, discussed the global harm reduction response, the need for scale-up and funding to ensure a stronger public health response to the world drug problem, and the future of harm reduction for people who use stimulants and women who use drugs.

The participants and presentations highlighted the importance and success of the harm reduction response to drugs, and the need to continue promoting effective drug policies that are based on public health and human rights.
