


Draft global health sector strategy on viral hepatitis, 2016-2021 - the first of its kind

Viral hepatitis is an international public health challenge, comparable to other major communicable diseases, including HIV, tuberculosis and malaria. Despite the significant burden it places on communities across all global regions, hepatitis has been largely ignored as a health and development priority until recently. It will no longer remain hidden, however, with the adoption of the resolution on the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.¹ Target 3 is of particular relevance: it calls for specific action to combat viral hepatitis.²

This is the first global health sector strategy on viral hepatitis, a strategy that contributes to the achievement of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. It covers the first six years of the post-2015 health agenda, 2016–2021, building on the *Prevention and Control of Viral Hepatitis Infection: Framework for Global Action*,³ and on two resolutions on viral hepatitis adopted by the World Health Assembly in 2010 and in 2014.⁴ The strategy addresses all five hepatitis viruses (hepatitis A, B, C, D and E), with a particular focus on hepatitis B and C, owing to the relative public health burden they represent.

The strategy describes the health sector contribution towards the elimination of viral hepatitis as a

What is NOhep?

- A **social justice movement** aimed at uniting the hepatitis community and beyond to take action, to speak out and be engaged to ensure global commitments are met and viral hepatitis is eliminated by 2030.
- An interactive platform which houses materials from across the hepatitis community and provides materials, tips and resources needed to take action.
- A **global advocacy platform** which supports single advocates to large organisations and provides them with support of a movement.
- An independent movement directed by the needs and priorities of the community





What does NOhep do?

- **Connects people** across the world who have a common goal of eliminating a global killer
- Lobbies governments and international organisations to make sure they drive action to eliminate viral hepatitis
- Inspires people and tells powerful stories of the achievements of people living with viral hepatitis
- Mobilises supporters across the globe to be part of the next greatest achievement
- **Campaigns** for a world where people have access to life saving interventions and do not suffer discrimination

- NOhep campaign: *NOhep...Our Next Greatest Achievement*
- Strong call to action for people to join to make the elimination of viral hepatitis our next greatest achievement
- It will take a fresh approach to campaigning by focusing and profiling achievements rather than focusing on scare tactics




