## Call for Proposals Drug Policy Networking Zone XVIII International AIDS Conference (AIDS 2010) Vienna, Austria

IDPC and Transform have been successful in our application for a Drug Policy Networking Zone at the upcoming International AIDS Conference. There has been agreement that the Drug Policy Networking Zone will be co-located together with the Human Rights and Harm Reduction Networking Zones. This will allow all three groups to benefit from the use of a much larger space in which to hold events and activities throughout the conference. The plan is to divide the space into:

- A seated area (approx 60-100 chairs) with a stage for talks, panel discussions, film shows, etc
- An area with tables for literature dissemination (divided into distinct drug policy, harm reduction and human rights sections)
- An area with sofas and desks for networking, relaxing and informal meetings

The networking zones are located in the Global Village and we hope to use the drug policy space to give prominence to the intersecting issues of drug policy and HIV/AIDS. An open and participatory approach is key to the ethos of the conference. We are circulating this call amongst IDPC members and other drug policy groups. If you are attending the conference we encourage you to propose activities for the zone relating to your areas of expertise that will be of interest to the AIDS 2010 conference delegates. This is a great opportunity to raise the profile of key issues and debates in drug policy (in particular those beyond the more traditional remit of harm reduction) with a broad and influential international audience.

Given the nature of the conference it is important to keep proposals relevant to HIV/AIDS, but the aim of having a distinct drug policy section is to allow a more focused exploration of the wider impact policy and legal environments on drug use and HIV/AIDS. We will aim to look at issues around policy and law reform (current trends towards decriminalisation, and future developments for regulation), and the various impacts of policy environments on service provision. We welcome any other suggestions and ideas.

Submissions will be reviewed in early May together with those received for the human rights and harm reduction activities being coordinated by the Canadian HIV/AIDS Legal Network and IHRA respectively — with whom we will be working closely. Where there is obvious cross-over we may suggest merging certain proposals — but this will all be discussed when we have a clearer idea of what is on the table. We will notify applicants of the status of their applications no later than May 31, 2010.

The literature dissemination area of the networking zone will is also open for drug policy organisations to take advantage of. If you would like to take advantage of this then please email <a href="mailto:jane@tdpf.org.uk">jane@tdpf.org.uk</a>.

We would very much value volunteer support for the zone activities throughout the week to help it run smoothly and maximise our impact. If you are able to help as a volunteer, please let us know even if you are not contributing a proposal for the zone's program of activities.

- The zone will open on Sunday, July 18 and close on Thursday, July 22.
- The deadline for submitting this application form is Friday, April 30, 2010 (the earlier the better).
- The events will be English language and translation will not be available. We will consider proposals for sessions to take place in Russian.
- The zones can only provide the facilities for hosting events, and are not in a position to provide funding for delegates.
