



Biography Luigi Longo

Luigi Longo is the Chief Scientific Officer at Cosmo, where he leads the research and development activities of the pharmaceutical division with a focus on gastroenterology and dermatology. In this role, he oversees the pharmaceutical development, preclinical development, clinical development, regulatory affairs, intellectual property, and pharmacovigilance departments.

Luigi brings nearly 20 years of experience in the pharmaceutical industry. He began his career at Cosmo in 2005 as a scientist in the Quality Control laboratories, later moving to the R&D laboratory department. In 2014, he became Scientific Project Manager, coordinating and contributing to several development programs. He subsequently worked closely with Cosmo's former Chief Scientific Officer, supporting the management of multiple projects and contributing to the successful completion of key R&D programs. Following his promotion to Deputy CSO, Luigi was appointed Chief Scientific Officer upon his predecessor's retirement.

He is an active contributor to several development programs, an inventor on multiple patent applications, and a co-author of scientific publications related to Cosmo's research.

Luigi holds a degree in Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technology from La Sapienza University of Rome and completed an Advanced Course in Management of Intellectual Property at the University of Milan.
