

Project Overview

Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) Skill Sets.

The scope of this project

This minor project will review the practical experience hour requirements contained within the following Temporary Traffic Management skill sets:

- RIISS00058 Traffic Controller – Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads
- RIISS00059 Traffic Controller Skill Set for High Volume Roads
- RIISS00061 Traffic Management Implementer Skill Set for High Volume Roads

Industry has informed BuildSkills that the practical experience hours embedded in these skill sets are creating barriers to workforce attraction, retention and training, and are contributing to broader workforce supply constraints.

The intent of this work is to test potential changes to these requirements against stakeholder feedback, to assess whether any adjustments align with industry requirements.

Initial Industry Connections

Initial feedback has been received from Austroads, various state and territory government agencies particularly those operating under the Temporary Traffic Management National Training Framework, as well as temporary traffic management businesses and RTOs delivering this training.

Engagement Plan

BuildSkills proposes a targeted engagement strategy with key stakeholders, particularly those operating within states and territories currently delivering or regulating the Temporary Traffic Management National Training Framework. This will include RTOs, industry businesses, unions, employers and employees.
