RELEASE 5: AVAILABLE WORKS

The pieces comprising RELEASE 5 were created ad-hoc for an exhibition at the 5th edition of Available Works, a book fair in Lower Manhattan. A loose collection of objects prompted by an invitation to participate in the fair, RELEASE 5 is (mostly) centered around simple wooden forms that have been flocked. A longtime obsession of ours, flocking reportedly dates back to ancient China, though our interest was piqued by its use in the automotive industry. Simply put, the nylon flocking fibers are applied to an adhesive-coated surface that has been given an electrostatic charge. The fibers are given a negative charge by the flocking gun, which results in the fibers orienting themselves vertically to the surface as they're buried into the glue.

In addition to the flocked pieces, RELEASE 5 includes a one-off floor lamp, salvaged from an earlier client project.

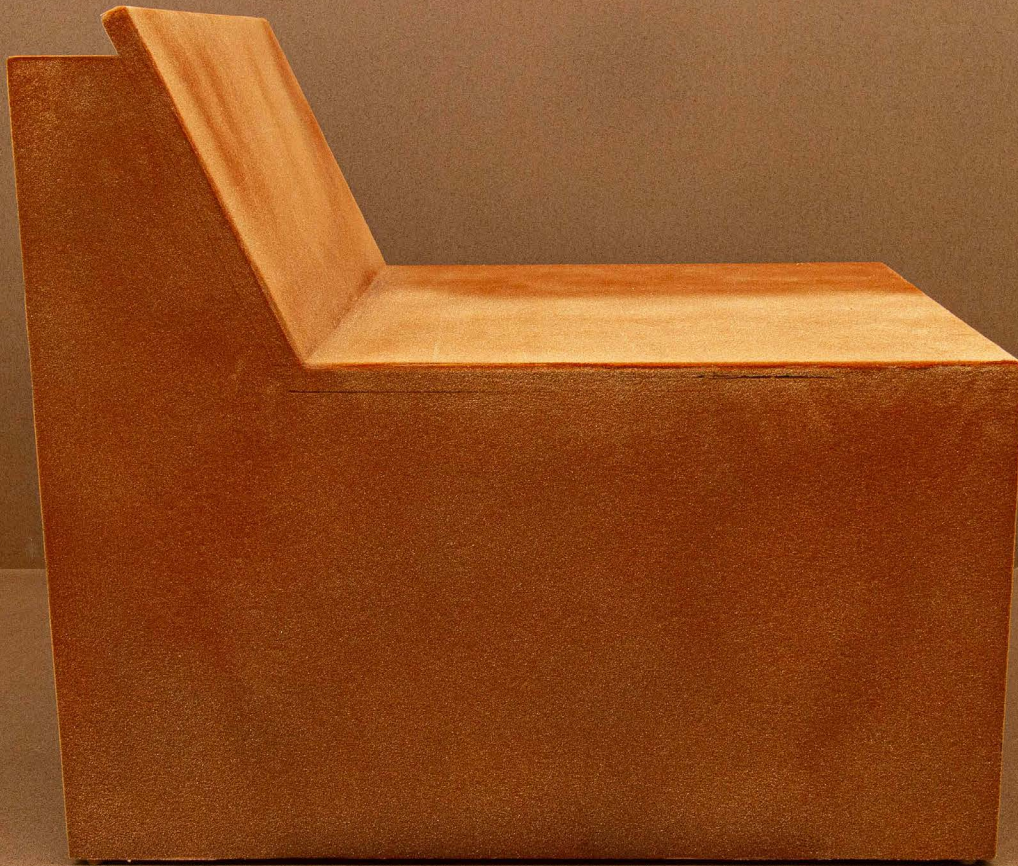

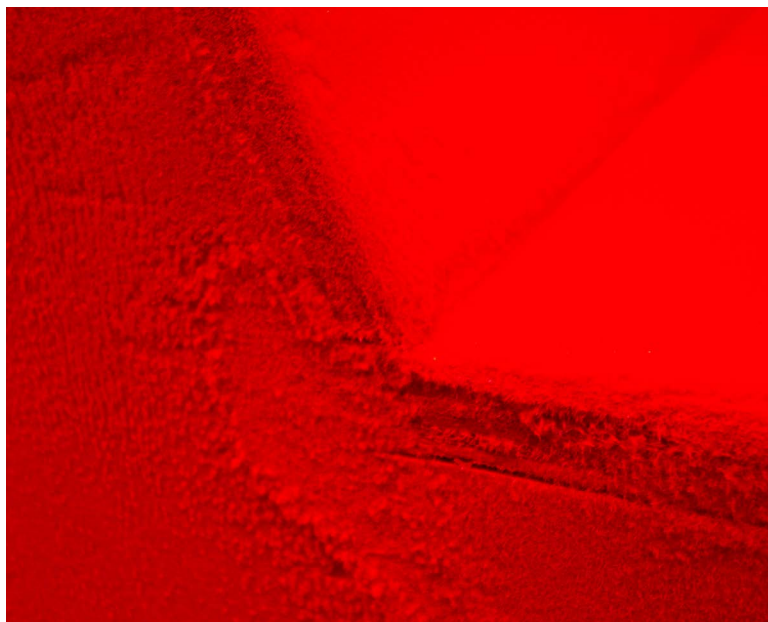
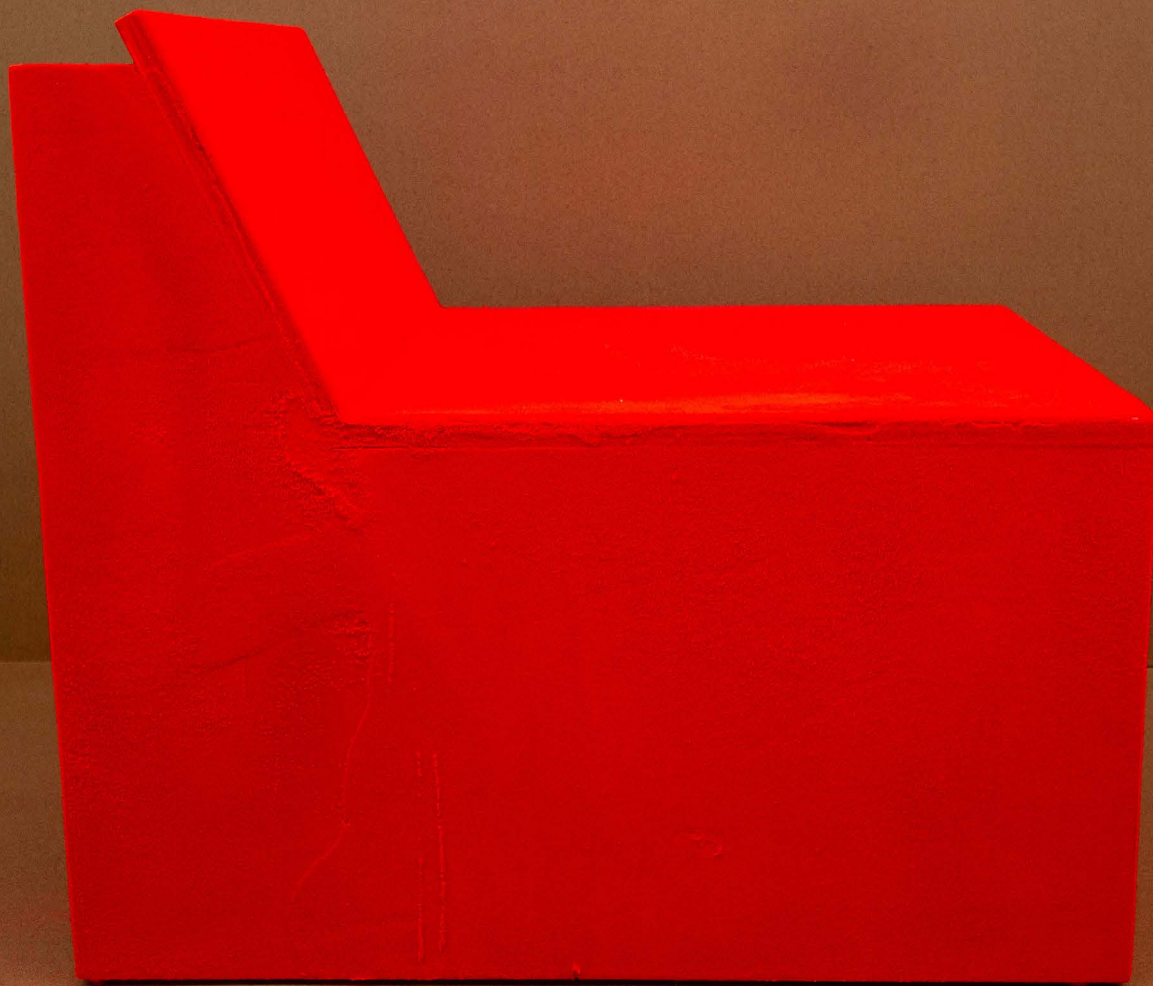

Plywood, paint, nylon flocking



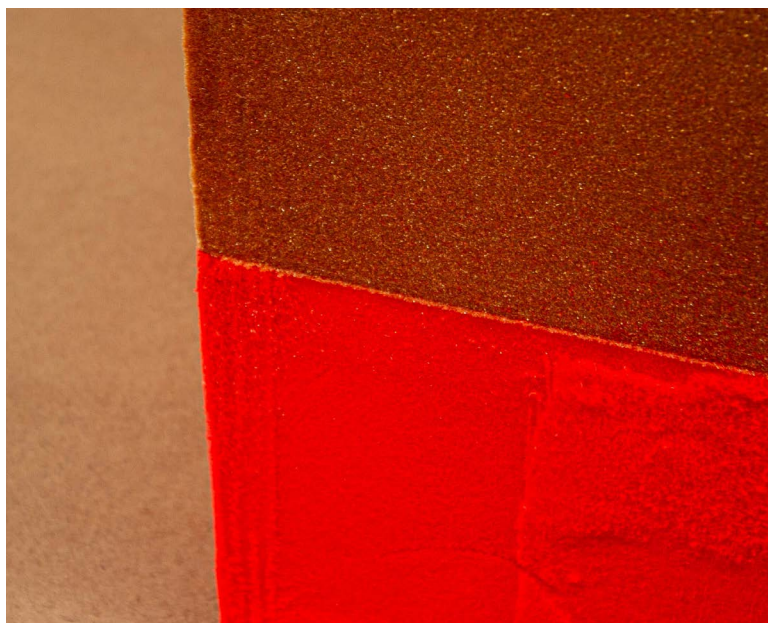
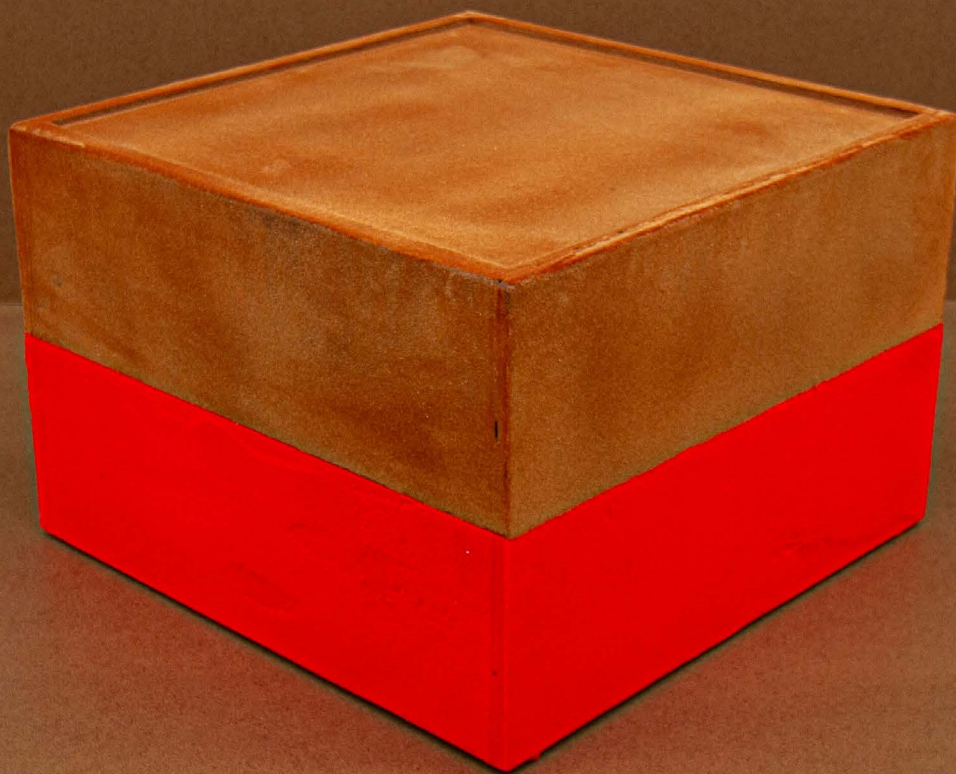
NEON CHAIR / R5-33

18.5W x 18.5D x 12.5H

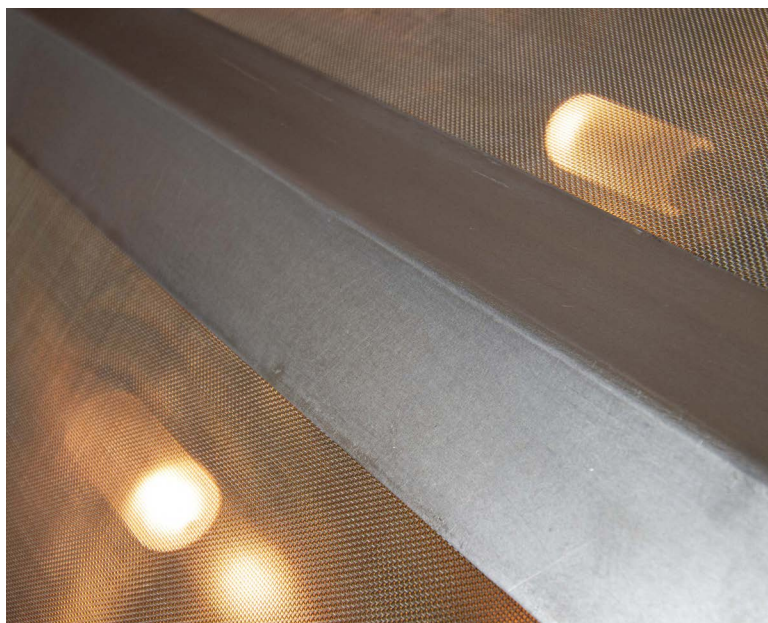
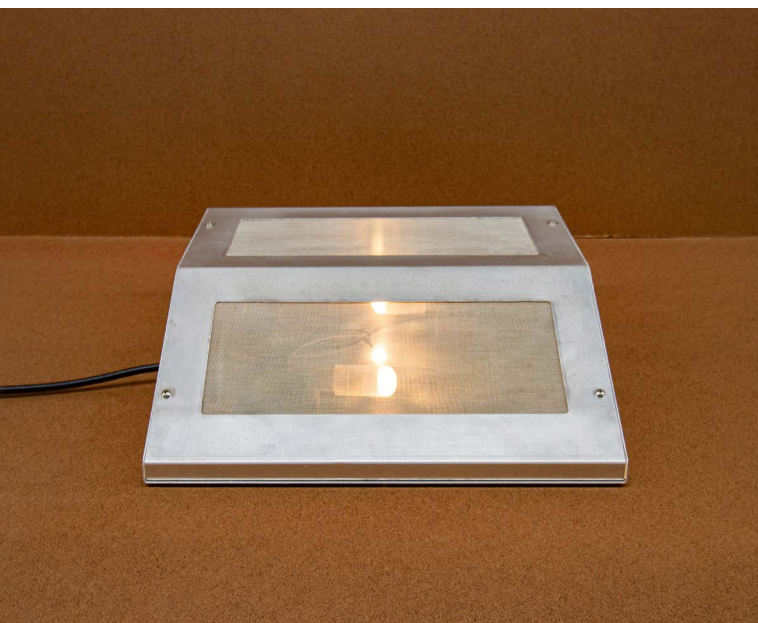
