One of the largest non-government funded aviation & space museums in the world! Featuring about 400 historic aircraft, from a Wright Flyer to a 787 Dreamliner. Sitting on 80 acres, the museum opened its doors to the public in May of 1976. Over the past forty years, the museum has grown immensely and today encompasses six indoor exhibit hangars (three dedicated to WWII).

Cost of the ride: \$53.50 (Refunds only if the trip is canceled)

Cost of the event: \$16.75 (for seniors only)

Pickup location: Copper Sky – northeast parking lot (by the playground & lake)

Pickup time: 8:00 am (Be on time – the van will only wait 5 minutes)

Event starts at: 9 am

Return drop-off time: 4:00 pm at Copper Sky

Sign-up deadline: November 5, 2024

Minimum sign-up needed for the trip: 10

Physical requirements: The museum covers 80 acres for walking – moderate. There is a 45 minute train ride which starts at 9:45 am for a cost of \$8.00. The museum is ADA accessible.

Other: There is a snack bar/grill for a light lunch available on site. **Please note:** If you leave the museum for any reason, you may be required to pay a new admission fee.

Accessibility information from the Museum:

All of the museum buildings are accessible. The floors are poured cement. Accessible parking spaces (handicapped permit required) are located near the entrance to the museum. A paved walkway connects the Main Hangar, Hangar 3, 4 and 5 while the remainder of the outdoor acreage is generally hard-packed dirt. **It can be difficult for a thin-wheeled vehicle to move easily in the areas with loose sand when viewing the 150 aircraft outdoors.**

Pima Air & Space Museum does not have wheelchairs available.

Liability Notice: THIS IS NOT A CITY EVENT. **Ride 347** for travel only. Personal liability is assumed by each participant.

1st come 1st served. Minimum age 55.

Ride 347 vans are ADA accessible: One van has 1 ramp, and the other van has 1 lift. Each van can handle 2 wheelchairs / scooters. Walkers can be stored in the back of the van.
