The City of Maricopa is offering two designated live Christmas tree disposal locations. They will be set up on December 23, 2024, and will remain open until January 13, 2025.

Tree Disposal Locations:

One disposal site is located on the southwest corner of Cesar Chavez and Plainview St.



Another site is across the street from the Maricopa Stanfield Justice Court on Wilson Ave.



The areas will be marked with cones and caution tape for easy identification.

Important Guidelines for Tree Disposal

To ensure a smooth and eco-friendly disposal process, please follow these guidelines:

- **Remove All Decorations**: Before bringing your tree to the disposal site, please remove all ornaments, lights, tinsel, and other decorations.
- No Tree Stands: Make sure the tree stand is removed from the tree before disposal. Only bare trees are accepted.
- Only Dispose of Trees in Marked Drop-off Areas: Ensure that you place your trees or wreaths
 only in the designated drop-off areas.

Please exercise care during drop-offs, as no staff will be available to assist with disposal. The dumping of any items other than Christmas trees is strictly prohibited.

Other Options

Local trash collection companies will have different options available for Holiday Tree Disposal depending on your servicing provider.

Waste Management

Schedule your bulk pickup disposal online via your account. Trees should not exceed maximum height of 6' (anything over 6' will need to be cut down), not stored in a bag, and should be free of all tinsel, lights, and ornaments.

Waste Connections of Arizona

Trees are accepted for "Bulk Collection". Contact WCofAZ by calling (844) 708-7274 to schedule pickup. Trees must be 4' or less and placed on the curb by 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.
