What is a Home Key Box?

A home key box is a small metal box which is permanently mounted on or near the exterior front entry of your home. The box holds copies of exterior door and other entry keys. The lock box can only be accessed by members of the City of Maricopa Fire & Medical Department (MF/M).

Why should I install a home key box?

In many emergency situations, an individual may not be able to open their door when first responders arrive. This is especially true with senior citizens, those with disabilities or injuries, and children. In these instances, every second counts and having a key box allows Maricopa Fire/Medical personnel quick and easy access to your home. Without the box, first responders may have to break through a door or a window, causing damage, costing money, and taking up valuable time.

How does the home key box program work?

A volunteer from Maricopa Seniors will deliver your lock box. We provide free installation upon request, or you can install it yourself per the instructions provided. Mounting hardware is included. Next, have copies of entry keys made, ready to be placed in the key box. Also, include alarm codes, if applicable. Contact MF/M to schedule an appointment. MF/MD Fire Corps volunteers will come and lock your keys in the lock box. Once installed and locked, only MF/M personnel can access the lock box. (Additional information provided with delivery of your lock box.)

What if I need help installing my key box?

Maricopa Seniors will install your key box free of charge. Simply check the "installation assistance" box when you place your order.
