Veteran's Day 2024 is Monday, Nov. 11. Veteran's Day honors the historical importance of the date but also celebrates and honors American veterans for "their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good." According to the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) November 11, 1918, is regarded as the end of "the war to end all wars".

World War I ended with the signing of the <u>Treaty of Versailles</u> on June 28, 1919. Seven months earlier the fighting ceased when a truce between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect causing a ceasefire on the <u>11th</u> hour of the 11th day of the 11th month.

Originally celebrated as Armistice Day, Veterans Day was first issued by President Woodrow Wilson a year after the end of WWI which occurred at 11AM on the 11th day and the 11th month in 1918. A day to honor the fallen soldiers of the Great War.

It wasn't until 1926 Congress adopted a resolution requested by President Coolidge proclaiming November 11th a legal holiday.

In 1945 Raymond Weeks a WWII veteran expanded Armistice Day to celebrate all veterans rather than just the ones who died in WWI. With the support of Gen. Eisenhower the first Armistice Day was signed into law on May 26th, 1954. On June 1st the bill was amended replacing "Armistice" to "Veterans".

# Across the USA by Train for Just \$213

**AMTRAK** is offering a scenic trip from San Francisco to New York.



Crossing the continent by train you will discover



many beauties of nature and unique landscapes in addition to traveling through 11 states and four time zones to eventually cross the entire continent of North America from coast to coast. They pointed out that you could also see the Pacific and the Atlantic Oceans without taking a flight.

This is a 3,400-mile journey from one coast to the other, a feat that can be accomplished in 4 days if

you choose not to make any stops. Simply purchasing direct tickets for the <u>California Zephyr</u> and <u>Lake Shore</u> <u>Limited</u> will transport you from San Francisco to New York, with prices starting at just \$ 186.

If you chose to make intermediate stops and make the most of the trip, Separate tickets must be purchased for each part, which would increase the cost of the trip. You must buy the 15-day rail pass for \$ 429,00 including eight train rides.

Also from Amtrak: AMTRAK is launching a new temporary route between Chicago and Miami.

The journey will take more than 40 hours, with multiple stops in Cleveland, Pittsburgh, Washington D.C., Jacksonville, Orlando and Tampa before arriving in Miami.

The route, called the <u>Floridian</u>, combines two existing routes, the <u>Capitol Limited</u> and <u>Silver</u> <u>Star</u>, because of the upcoming East River Tunnel project in New York.

The first trip will be on Sunday, November 10.

Why the "Beaver" Moon? This is the time of year when beavers begin to take shelter in their lodges,

having laid up sufficient food stores for the long winter ahead. During the fur trade in North America, it was also the season to trap beavers for their thick, winter-ready pelts.

This is the final supermoon of four consecutive supermoons of the year! This means that it will appear bigger and brighter than

normal! We experience one full moon every month, with each given a different evocative name A Supermoon is a phenomenon that occurs when the full moon or new moon coincides with the moon's closest approach to Earth in its orbit, known as perigee. Because the moon is closer to Earth during this time, it appears larger and brighter than usual, hence the name. It means that the moon appears up to 14 per cent larger and 30 per cent brighter than when it's at its furthest from Earth.
