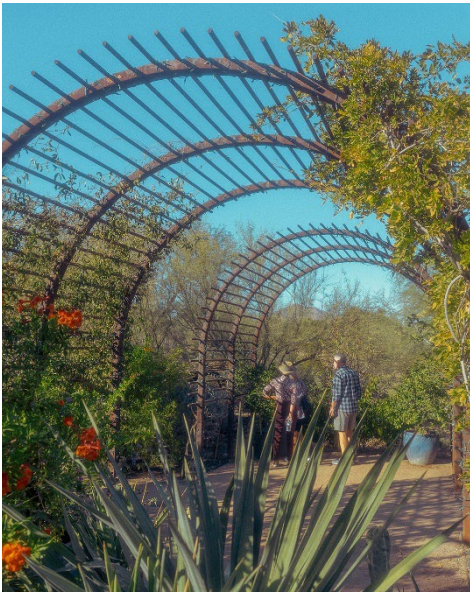
Liability Notice: This is not a City of Maricopa event. **Ride 347** is for travel only. Personal liability is assumed by each participant.
