

Urgent Dental of Denver Infection Control Protocols:

We have always applied the strictest, evidenced-based universal infection control measures in our dental practice and we will continue to follow the latest recommendations from the CDC.

Please remember the following:

- If you are not feeling well, running a temperature or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus, please notify our staff when you call for an appointment.
- We will ask you to complete and sign a Consent for Care During the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Anyone entering the office MUST wear a face covering / mask.
- We will ask you to wash your hands and rinse your mouth with a solution of 1.5% hydrogen to help minimize any bacterial or viral transmission in the saliva as recommended by the American Dental Association.
- We have hand sanitizer and hand washing stations throughout the office that we will encourage you to use.
- We will manage appointment times to allow for appropriate social distancing between patients.
- We will be regularly cleaning and disinfecting hard surfaces in the reception area including door handles. We have also increased the frequency of professional cleanings performed in our office.
- You may see that our waiting room is not currently offering magazines since they are difficult to clean and disinfect.
