Evening Before Surgery

Please follow these instructions very carefully as they are important to your health and safety. It may also cause delay or rescheduling of your surgery.

Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight the before your scheduled procedure. (This includes water, gum, candy, etc.)

If you are taking any medications for any reason, please disclose to your doctor so that special instructions may be given if necessary.

Morning of Surgery

Please arrive one hour prior to your scheduled surgery time. Upon arrival, you will be asked to complete admission and consent forms.

Prior to your surgery, you will meet with your anesthesiologist and pre-operative nurse and will have the opportunity to ask any last minute questions you may have.

We ask that you please leave all valuables at home or with your guest as you will be asked to remove all jewelry, contact lenses, etc. prior to surgery.

Wear loose, comfortable clothing that is easily removed and put back on for your convenience.

It is important that you plan ahead for transportation to and from your procedure. You will want to have someone available to drive you home and stay with you during the night should you need anything. Please

note that our waiting room is relatively small and does not accommodate large groups of people.

You will receive a phone call the day before your scheduled surgery from the SFSC Preoperative Nurse. If you do not receive a phone call by 3 pm, please give us a call at 415-393-9600.
