Evening Prior to Surgery

Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery, *including* water, gum and candy—nothing by mouth. These instructions are very important for your safety, so please follow them diligently (unless otherwise instructed by your surgeon or anesthesiologist). Any deviation may result in a need to delay, cancel and/or reschedule your surgery. If you take any medications, please inform your doctor so that special instructions may be given.

Morning of Surgery

Please arrive prior to your scheduled surgery (typically 60-90 minutes earlier—to be confirmed during your conversation with a Webster Surgery Center -SF pre-operative nurse). Upon arrival, you will be asked to present two forms of identification (one must be a photo ID), and to complete admission and consent forms. We will also ask you for your preferred pharmacy, and contact information for your ride home.

Please leave all valuables at home (*except* ID, insurance, and forms of payment if necessary). You will be asked to remove all jewelry, contact lenses, etc, and therefore, we recommend that all valuables be left at home.

Wear loose, comfortable clothing that is easily removed (and easy to put on when you get ready to go home) for your convenience.

If you receive sedation or anesthesia, please arrange for a responsible adult to accompany you home; you may not drive yourself home, or go home unaccompanied in a taxi. Please note that our waiting area is relatively small and therefore may not be able to accommodate a large number of people.

Prior to your surgery, you will meet with your anesthesiologist and pre-operative nurse, and will have the opportunity to ask any last minute questions.

Plan to arrive prior to your scheduled surgery (typically 60-90 minutes earlier—to be confirmed during your conversation with a Webster Surgery Center – SF pre-operative nurse). You will receive a phone call within two weeks prior to your scheduled surgery from a Webster Surgery Center-SF preoperative nurse. If you would like to contact us, feel free to call us at 415-393-9588, Monday – Friday, 7am-5pm.

- By now you have discussed your procedure with your doctor. Please communicate all questions and concerns with your doctor in order to assure your satisfaction prior to your surgery.
- A Webster Surgery Center – SF Pre-operative Nurse will call you within two weeks prior to your scheduled surgery. If you would like to contact us, feel free to call us at 415-393-9588, Monday – Friday, 7am-5pm.
- If you experience a change in your health, such as a fever, please notify your doctor prior to surgery.
- Remember: you must have a responsible adult accompany you home after surgery. If you have any concerns about this, please notify your surgeon and call Webster Surgery Center- SF prior to your surgery.
- Remember: do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery!
- Remember: bring two forms of identification (one must be a photo ID), your insurance card(s), and a form of payment if necessary. (We accept Cash, Visa, Master card, and cashier's checks. Please no personal/corporate checks.)

Santa Rosa / Marin County (North Bay)

- Take US-101 south
- Left on Bush Street – Right on Grant Street – Right on Sutter Street.

San Jose / Redwood City / Daly City (South Bay)

- Take US-101 north toward San Francisco
- Take 4th Street Exit and merge on to Bryant Street – Turn left on 3rd Street, cross Market Street and merge onto Kearny Street – Turn left on Sutter Street.

Hayward / Oakland / Pleasanton / Richmond (East Bay)

- Take I-80 west towards San Francisco
- Take the I-80 west to Bay Bridge/San Francisco – Take Fremont Street exit – left on Mission Street – right on 3rd street, cross Market Street and merge onto Kearny Street – Turn left on Sutter Street.
