System says, You | Are | Describing | A | Reality | Without | Me? Poetry Book says, chill out. Sit down. You are particular too, aren't you?

A unique system derived from frail circumstance and not another system but yourself, corralled into order by a wider disorder, organised into a relativity of shape and sound, precipitous and ragged as the faces of clouds?

System stares out the window across the forecourt of the service station. Drinks coffee. Wipes mouth. Can | We | Go | Home?

System asks? Yes, says Poetry Book.

But where is home? System smiles.

Anywhere | I Guess | And Now.



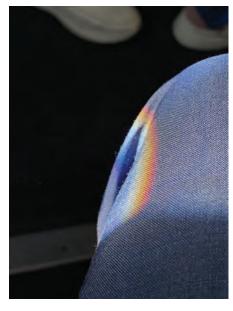
