



### Highlights

- Domestic visitation to NSW continued to record an upward trend in YE March 2023, and with the international borders re-opening in February 2022 which extended to all international travellers in July 2022, international visitation to NSW also showed signs of recovery
- NSW remains number one in Australia for total volume of international and domestic overnight and day trip visitors, nights and expenditure.
- Sydney is number one among all Australian capital cities for total visitors (28%), nights (31%) and expenditure (29%).
- Regional NSW (RNSW) leads regional Australia in share of total visitors (32%).
- Regional NSW has the lion's share of all visitors, nights and expenditure to NSW.

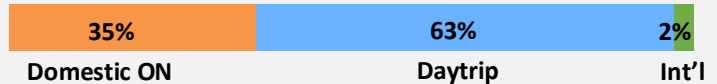

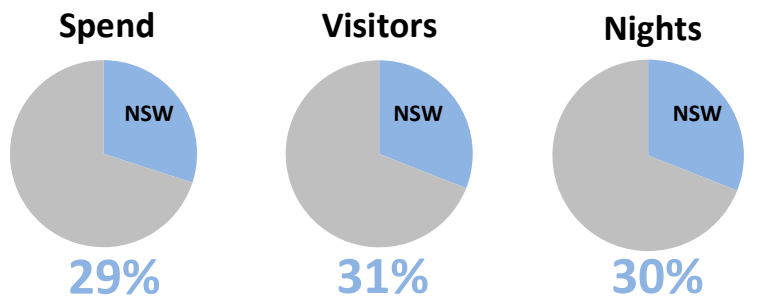
