The **Salish Sea & Me Tour** is designed to highlight the deep connection the Coast Salish peoples have with the Salish Sea, which has shaped their culture, identity, and way of life. This 1-hour walking tour begins at Stanley Park and, if timed correctly with low tide, can include a scavenger hunt activity on the beach, developed with guidance from a marine biologist. Indigenous stewardship, marine ecosystems, and the interconnectedness of ocean life are explored, while emphasizing advocacy for environmental responsibility and Indigenous rights. 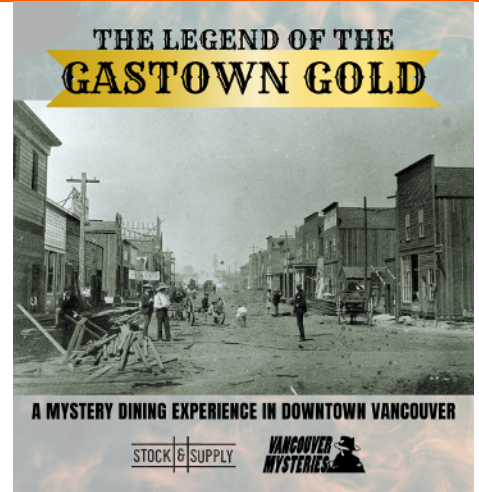

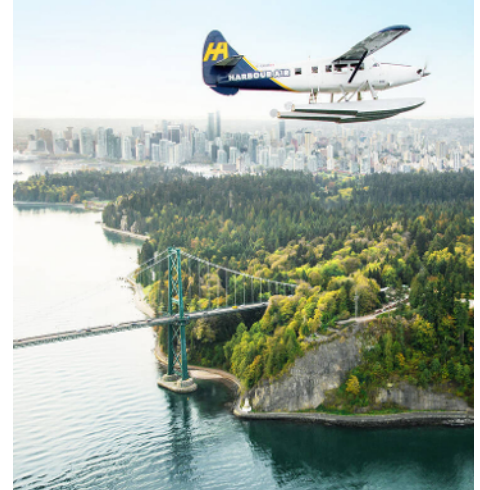

2026 FIFA World Cup
