**GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE & TRANSPORT HUB UPDATE
22ND FEBRUARY 2021**

Purpose of Report:

To update Sustainable Glasgow Board on progress and actions associated with the Green Infrastructure & Transport Hub.

- Following the workshop held on Friday 22nd Jan 2021, themes, city net zero activities, stakeholder activities and the focus of other hubs are now better understood with interdependencies known and mapped (and UoS expertise engaged).
- Second meeting of GITH took place Monday 22nd February 2021, 9am-10am.
 - An overview of Themes/Scope, Sub Themes, Principles and proposed outcomes and metrics, activities across Glasgow and mapping of GITH interests into action areas of GCC Climate Emergency Implementation were presented to the GITH meeting on 22nd February 2021. This will be a useful document to start initial discussions with other hubs to ensure discussion and clarity.
 - A draft project plan (potential milestones/activities to December 2021) has been produced, which requires further detail on project specific milestones as these develop.
 - Workshop planning was discussed and workshops were proposed in the areas of:
 - Electrification of Energy and Transport with application of sub-themes
 - Transport and Active travel with application of sub themes
 - Climate Adaptation with application of sub themes
 - Systems overview
 - A draft Terms of Reference document for the Green Infrastructure and Transport Hub was reviewed, with input obtained on 'Scope specific to Green Infrastructure and Transport Hub' and 'Mode of Operation' sections.
- Collation of expertise lists aligned with areas/actions from GCC Climate Emergency Implementation plan continues.
- Dates for monthly meetings to November 21 established.
