Spare parts or items inside to be properly secured. Lashings must be fixed to suitable lashing points on the main unit.







Loose items or any personal effects inside of any unit not allowed




Loose items or any personal effects inside of any unit not allowed

They are not designed to withstand the forces at sea.



Side curtains must be opened/removed to evaluate correct securing.



3. Cargo leaking any fluids (e.g. Gasoline, Diesel, Lubricants etc)




Units leaking any fluids will be rejected from loading


Units leaking any fluids will be rejected from loading, also when stuffed as piggy backed.

4. Broken windows blocking view, or any sharp edges




Any broken windows MUST be replaced or totally removed.

# 5. Steel and Metal Plates/Pipes/Rails/Beams/Bars in any configuration directly "on deck"



Plates, pipes, rails directly on deck not allowed.

MUST be stowed correctly on Rolltrailer



Beams, Sheet piles, Slabs directly on deck is not allowed MUST be stowed correctly on Rolltrailer






