The GT AirWing<sup>TM</sup> can be **retrofitted to large ships** and newbuilds alike to reduce their fuel burn and carbon emissions



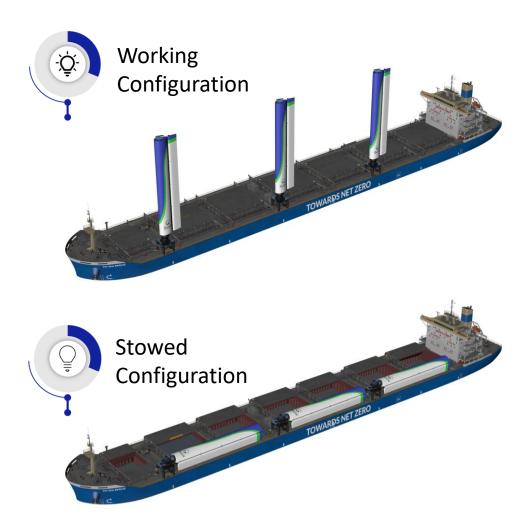

Our AirWing<sup>™</sup> product is **a technical leap forward** versus alternative wind propulsion devices on the market

GT's AirFlow technology employs an innovative system designed to enhance airflow dynamics by strategically manipulating air movement within and around the device

This novel and patented approach improves flow attachment and achieves industry highest lift and thrust coefficients. As a result, we can deliver outstanding fuel and carbon savings from a more compact and lightweight unit than alternative systems

Our compact size means that AirWing™ has minimal effect on cargo operations and can be used on vessels with limited available deck space

We have undertaken many months of detailed technical work to verify our results, investing over £300k to date on R&D. Our results have been independently reviewed by multiple partners and funders, who share our excitement about AirWing's potential impact on the sector

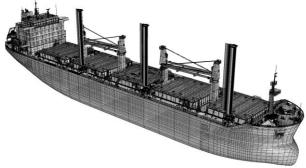

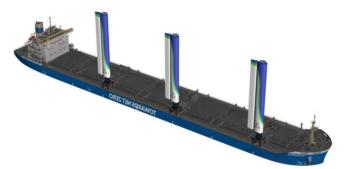












The AirWing<sup>TM</sup> family will ultimately comprise 3 products (20m, 30m and 40m heights), that will enable us to service the majority of the global commercial shipping market



Initial AirWing20 installation on Carisbrooke Shipping 124m Vectis 11k Vessel in late 2024. We are targeting sales of multiple additional 20m units in 2024 for delivery in H2 2025



First 30m unit targeted for installation in late 2025 / early 2026, with 40m unit following shortly thereafter



GT's modular design approach involves standard components and **10m sections**, allowing for **rapid scalability** from **AirWing20** to **AirWing30** and **Airwing40** 

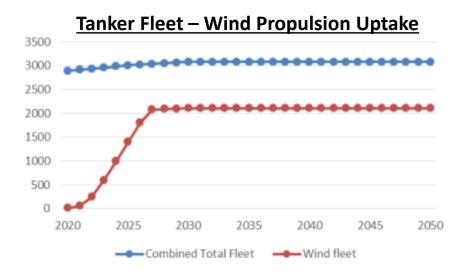
### Huge, High Growth Market

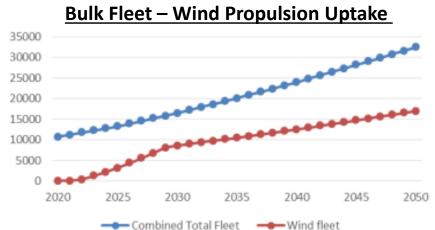






With over 20,000 ships globally suitable for WPT, the market potential is enormous. Numerous large shipowners are now looking to place orders for multiple units in 2025





Independent studies commissioned by the EU demonstrate the anticipated near-term growth in WPT uptake



Combined fleet employing WPT estimated at **over 11,000 ships by 2030**, with **>1,500 ships per annum** installing WPT. This compares to just ~35 global installations today!



This could represent up to **7,000 separate wing installations** per annum, or a **TAM of over \$11bn** p.a. by 2030



Just a 2% market share would deliver **financial results well in excess of our conservative projections** – in practice we expect to do much better!

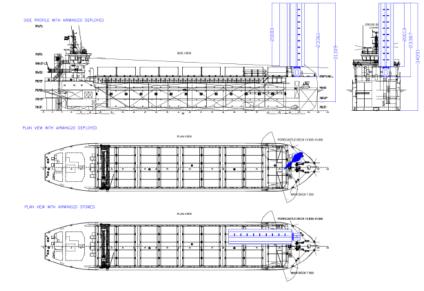

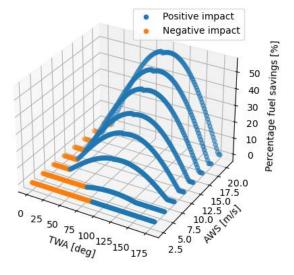


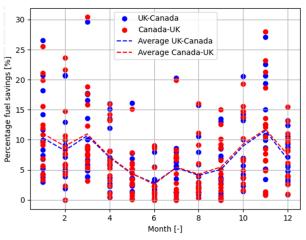
