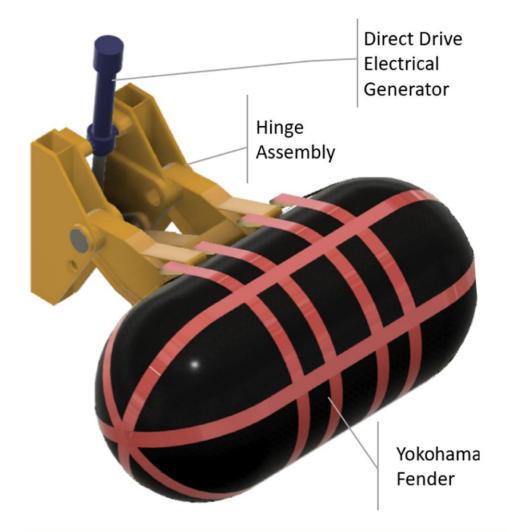


Executive Summary

- Aslihan Penley, an award-winning businesswoman with Masters degree in Chem. is the founder of ZOEX LTD, a clean technology, aiming to replace the diesel generators used in the Blue economy. Ash transitioned her career from offshore Oil & Gas to Renewables sector because of her passion for SCUBA diving as she witnessed the devastation in aquatic life due to climate change. She previously worked for FTSE 500 companies such as Subsea7, Technip and Worley, with global experience in Australia and America.
- ZOEX is a wave energy converter overcoming the biggest hurdle in the sector: cost. ZOEX cuts down the cost drastically by developing a wave energy technology that can be mounted on an existing marine structure.
- ZOEX is a modular wave energy device with 100kW peak power.
- Multiples can be installed to meet the customer demand
- It is easy to transport, install and maintain
- ZOEX found a penetration market in aquaculture sector by gaining support letters from Scottish Sea farms, Bakkafrost and AKVA Group
- The company secured Grant funding from Seafood Innovation fund and working towards a Demo project in 2024
- Further funding secured from Innovate UK Future economies to establish the company. Innovate UK funding can be unlocked by raising private equity investment and we currently raising Seed level investment with Equity Gap





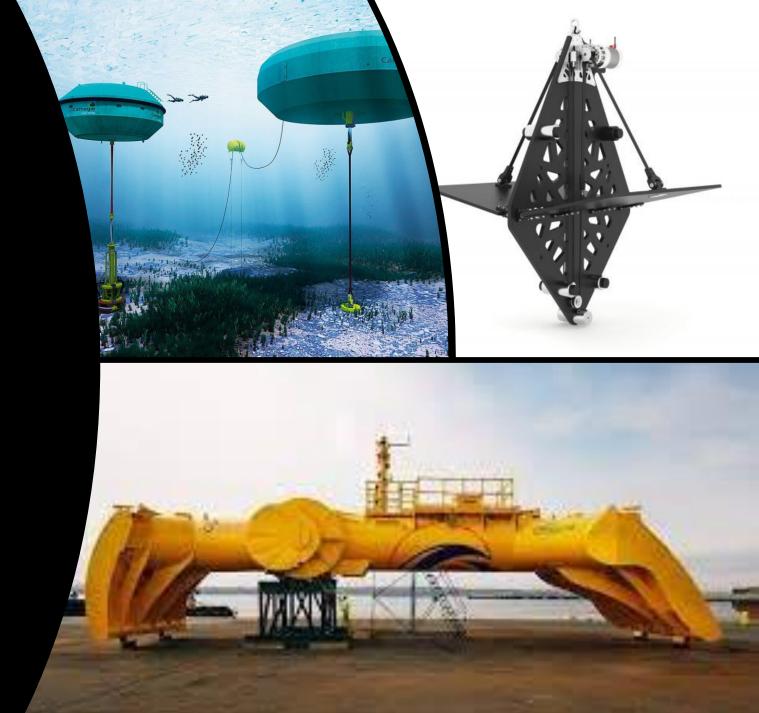

How it works

- A compliant rubber Yokohama fender moves up and down as a wave actuated-body. The fender also protects the host structure
- The fender's movement is captured by Umbra Group's Electro-Mechanical Generator (EMG), which provides precise control, high efficiency, and reliability
- Hinge assembly on the arm works both as a mechanical intensifier mechanism so that the device generates at small Sea States with improved performance and utilisation and avoids mechanical end stop at storms

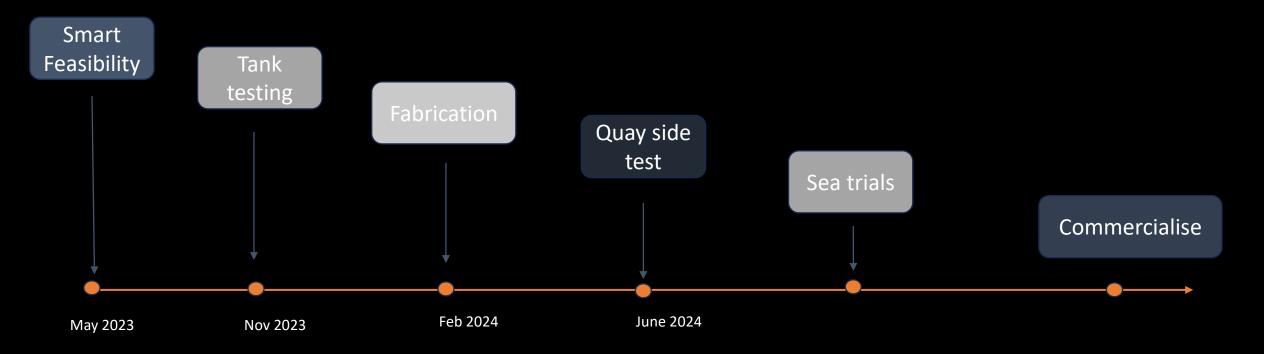






- Stand-alone power buoy supported with subsea battery storage would service IoT, marine sensors and Oil & Gas subsea infrastructure. We are already talking with Verlume and Krucial.
- Floats can be lifted-up for ease of transport, a vessel handler can carry 3-4 of these at its backdeck. Easy to install.

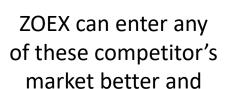

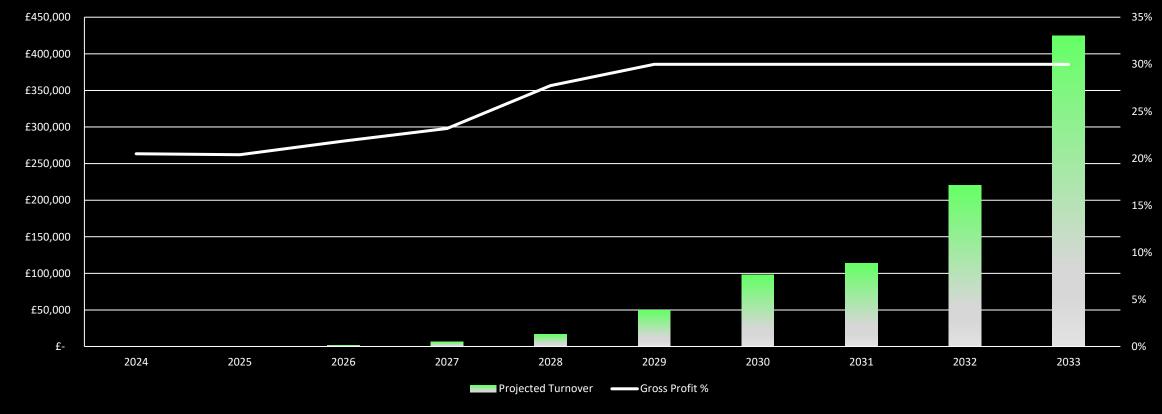


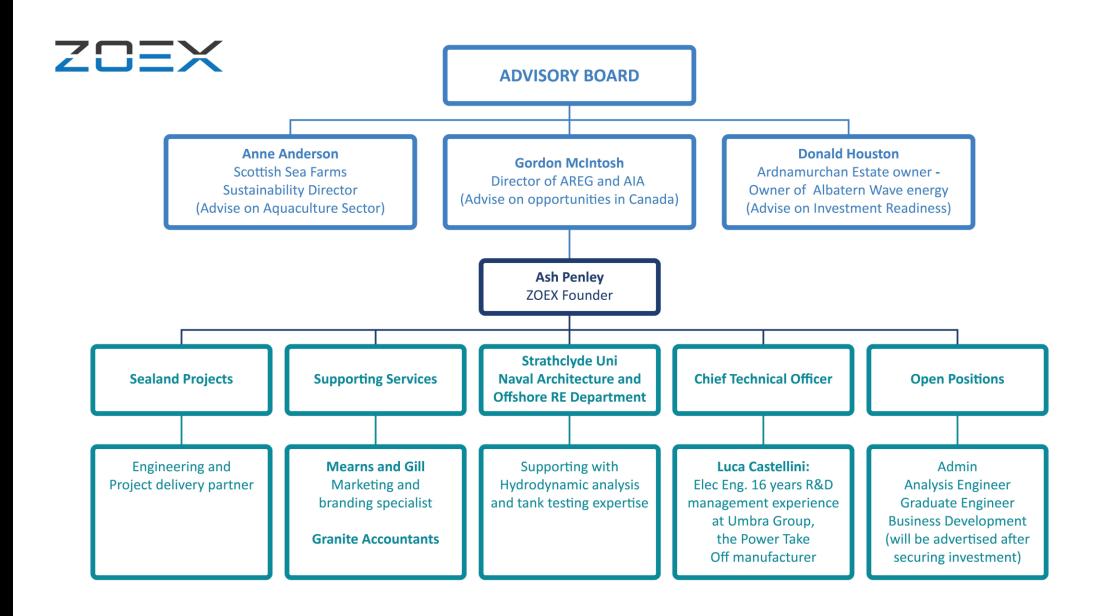

ZOEX for Aquaculture

Hinge mechanism (the yellow part inside the blue elbow) which was developed for Albatern is adapted in ZOEX. This has been in water in West coast of Scotland to date. This mechanism overcomes the biggest challenge in Wave Energy sector; prevents mechanical end-stop and acts as an intensifier, which makes it work effectively at small sea states while surviving storms

Power Take off System adapted in ZOEX Concept is Electro Mechanical Generator (EMG) developed by Umbra Group SpA by WES funds.

This is a cutting-edge tech which has increased reliability and low maintenance. Small pic shows the EMG's sea-trials in Orkney on a single point pivot steel float

ZOEX concept was born during SE:SMART Peterhead Harbour Feasibility study. Numeric models were built to identify the power generation and stress analysis.

LCOE was identified as £170-400/MWh for prototype level. SE: Unlocking Ambition Product-market fit study done and identified offshore-off-grid applications such as the aquaculture sector

Patent Pending

Net Buoy Project funded by WES, tested a Yokohama fender as a wave absorber.

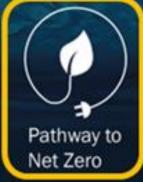

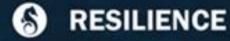

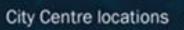
