		Product Identification Net quantity of contents shall be expressed in terms of weight or mass, measure, numerical count, or combination so as to give accurate information to facilitate consumer comparison (U.S. and metric units).
Country of Origin Marking	19 CFR 134.11	Shall indicate country of origin legibly, permanently, and incomparable size and close proximity to any mention of country other than country in which the article was manufactured or produced. Must be visible at point of purchase.
GRAS Evaluation in Glass Composition	FDA – Generally Recognized as Safe (GRAS) Guidelines	Shall meet FDA GRAS Guidelines. Documents such as Mill certificate (or test report) showing material composition of glass is acceptable

Externally Decorated	(San Francisco Superior Court, CGC-05- 440811) Ghost Wipe™ test	The exterior surface produces a result of 1.0 micrograms or less lead and 8.0 micrograms or less cadmium
External Decorations within the Lip & Rim Area	(San Francisco Superior Court, CGC-05- 440811)	All exterior decoration that extends into the Lip & Rim Area must contain Lead: ≤200 ppm Cadmium: ≤800 ppm
California Prop 65	Warning label or applicable testing	In lieu of warning label, product should meet all applicable Prop 65 requirements.
Total heavy metals in packaging	Toxics in Packaging Clearinghouse (TPCH)	Packaging shall not contain the sum of mercury, cadmium, lead and chromium (VI) in concentration above 0.01% by weight.
Plastic Bag Warnings	Various state laws	Plastic bags with a thickness of less than 1 mil (0.001 inch) having an opened end larger than 5 inches in diameter shall contain the following warning statement equivalent: <b>WARNING: To avoid danger of suffocation, keep this plastic bag away from babies and children. Do not use this bag in cribs, beds, carriages or playpens. This bag is not a toy.</b>
