



FDA GRAS – STAINLESS STEEL FLATWARE REQUIREMENTS

Burlington Stores requires the suppliers of flatware to use stainless steel to meet FDA regulations and recommendation for food contact materials

REQUIREMENTS:

Please provide the below product specifications to Burlington Stores product team for approval of your flatware shipment.

- 1- Guarantee letter that the product is labeled correctly with below information
 - a. Product Identification
 - b. Country of Origin Marking
 - c. Net quantity of contents
 - d. Manufacturer, packer, or distributor's name & address (city, state & zip)
 - e. Picture of packaging showing the above requirements
- 2- Mill certificate (test report) indicating the material composition of stainless steel including percentage of Chromium.
- 3- In case of missing Mill certificate, testing is required to make sure the stainless steel meets the FDA requirement for direct food contact

NOTE:

Stainless steel with less than 16% Chromium is more prone to corrosion and visual change. It is highly recommended you perform "Corrosion Test" independently to see the quality of your product. This is for your own information and is not a requirement from Burlington Stores. The corrosion test consists of a salt spray with 1% salt solution for 24 hours.
