POLICY AGAINST MERCHANDISE MANUFACTURED BY NORTH KOREAN NATIONALS AND CITIZENS

The recently enacted Countering America's Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (CAATSA) prohibits entry of merchandise produced by North Korean nationals or citizens anywhere across supply chains globally. Goods mined, produced, or manufactured wholly or in part by North Korean nationals or North Korean citizens, anywhere in the world, are presumed to be goods produced using forced-labor and, therefore, prohibited from importation under the Tariff Act. Such goods are subject to detention, seizure, and forfeiture. Violations may result in civil penalties as well as criminal prosecution.

Burlington is committed to respecting human rights and labor rights throughout its supply chain. Burlington will not do business with any vendors, factories and agents that employ North Korean nationals or North Korean citizens. In the event that a business partner fails to adhere to this we will cease doing business with that partner immediately.
