Requirements:

- Some relevant experience in a communication related role, ideally within a nonprofit, NGO or advocacy context.
- Educated to degree level or equivalent (bachelor's degree in communications, journalism or media)
- Fluent written and spoken English and Spanish, with English as your first language.
- You agree to commit at least 6 months, preferable is a commitment of 1 year.
- Experience with writing, editing, marketing, pro-

motion, filmmaking, and video.

- Experience using Facebook, Instagram, and other social media for advocacy, marketing, and product placement.
- Skilled with a range of digital communication tools and platforms, excellent computer literacy.
- A positive attitude and the ability to have a flexible approach.
- Commitment to the Chaikuni Institute's vision, mission, and values.

Desirable requirements:

- Photography skills and experience in photo-editing and design (Adobe Creative Suite).
- Experience working with indigenous peoples and permaculture.
- Experience and knowledge of geo-political context in Peru and Latin America.
