JOB SUMMARY

An electrician is responsible for installing and repairing complex electrical controls, wiring, and lighting systems working from technical blueprints. This position also assists in supervising and training apprentices.

DUTIES

- Install electrical controls, wiring, and lighting systems
- Read and interpret technical diagrams, blueprints, drawings, and specifications
- Troubleshoot electrical issues using appropriate testing devices
- Replace equipment, electrical wiring, or fixtures
- Install life safety systems, including fire alarm, nurse call, emergency lighting, and generators
- Prepare and assemble conduits and connect wiring through them
- Complete work within expected timelines
- Complete work per Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) code
- Take ownership of a job and provide leadership and training to assigned staff as needed
- Perform other duties as assigned
