Job Description

As an electrician-in-training, working under a licensed electrician's direct supervision, the apprentice is responsible for installing and repairing complex electrical control, wiring, and lighting systems from technical blueprint(s). This position will typically work on new-build, large-scale construction and renovation projects.

Roles & Responsibilities

- Install all types of electrical conduits
- Install surface mount, underground and overhead cables
- Splice, join and connect wires
- Install and replace electrical controls and panel boxes
- Install electrical systems such as fire alarm and lighting control
- Measure voltage, amperage and resistance with a digital multimeter
- Troubleshoot and isolate faults
- Install and replace lighting fixtures and equipment, including switches and circuit breakers

- Read and interpret drawings, schematics and specifications
- Adhere to occupational health and safety regulations
- Perform other duties as assigned
