JOB SUMMARY

As an electrician-in-training, working under a licensed electrician's direct supervision, the apprentice is responsible for installing and repairing complex electrical control, wiring, and lighting systems working from technical blueprint(s).

DUTIES

1. Install all types of electrical conduits
2. Install surface mount, underground and overhead cables
3. Splice, join and connect wires
4. Install and replace electrical controls and panel boxes
5. Install electrical systems such as fire alarm and lighting control
6. Measure voltage, amperage and resistance with a digital multimeter
7. Troubleshoot and isolate faults
8. Install and replace lighting fixtures and equipment, including switches and circuit breakers
9. Read and interpret drawings, schematics and specifications
10. Adhere to occupational health and safety regulations
11. Perform other duties as assigned
