- give good support to members and keep them safe.




People First will keep your information:

- in a locked cupboard at National Office
- on the membership database, that only People First staff can see.



People First will keep your information until you tell us that you no longer want to be a member.




If you tell us that you no longer want to be a member we will get rid of your information in a safe way.



People First NZ will not share your information with anyone unless:

- you have said we can
- it is an emergency about your health or life
- we have to by law.



You have the right to:

- see the information People First NZ has about you
- change it if it is wrong.
