

# SUCH-A-DBAG USE AND PACKING

The Squirrel semi-stowless deployment bag functions similarly to other d-bags you will be familiar with. There are three locking stows, and a line compartment.

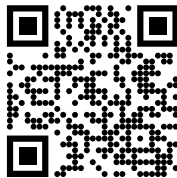
## ASSEMBLY:

Pass the bridle through the bottom grommet and attach it to the top surface of your parachute. Consult the manual of your harness-container system and main canopy to ensure that the deployment bag is assembled correctly, and fits your main parachute and main container properly.

## PACKING:

Fold the parachute into the bag.



Close the bag by double-wrapping line bights of 5-6cm in length with a standard band, as shown.

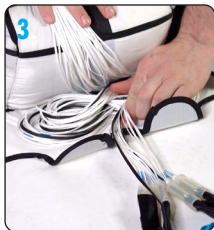


Figure-8 the lines. Ensure the line bights fit within the dimensions of the line compartment flaps.



Secure the side flap and line compartment tuck tabs.

**5** Place in the main container. The d-bag should be oriented according to the main container manual. Some users of "open corners / dynamic corners" containers prefer to orient the d-bag grommet toward the BoC. Most main containers specify that the grommet should be oriented toward the reserve compartment.
