## **Trial Objective**

To test the effects of Bontera® Impact, Bontera® Dynamik-T and Bontera® FungiBac, used individually and in combination, on the yield of dryland soybeans.

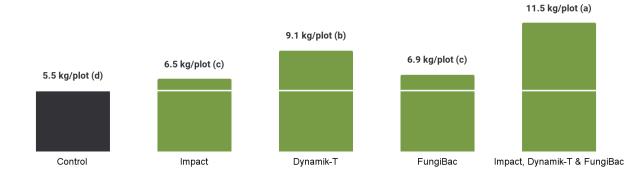

### **Conclusions**

- Bontera® Impact applied in-furrow resulted in a 19% increase in yield.
- Bontera® Dynamik-T applied in-furrow and at R1 resulted in a 66% increase in yield.
- Bontera® FungiBac applied at V4 and R1 resulted in a 26% increase in yield.
- The combination of Bontera® products resulted in an 111% increase in yield.

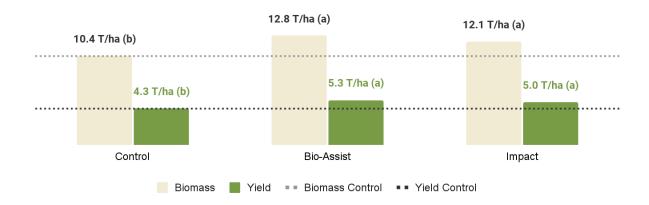

### **Conclusions**

- Bontera® Bio-Assist sprayed every 4 weeks resulted in a 23% increase in both yield and biomass
- Bontera® Impact sprayed every 4 weeks resulted in a 16% increase in both yield and biomass.

Bontera® Impact was applied at a rate of **100g/ha** in-furrow at planting.

### **Results**



### Conclusion

- Bontera® Impact replaced 25% of the growers' standard fertilizer, resulted in a 22% increase in yield and a 246% increase in nodulation.
- Without reducing fertilizer Bontera® Impact resulted in a 19% increase in yield and a 160% increase in nodulation.

Bontera® Impact was applied at a rate of **25g/ha** in-furrow at planting on 2 Dec 2014. A follow-up application was done on 5 Jan 2015 at **25g/ha** as a foliar spray tank mixed with 2L/ha of glyphosate 360.
