- You have an adult contact that is responsible for your entry, if you are under 16
- Avoid explicit content your film should not exceed an M "mature" rating

Message delivery - Getting your message across, making an impact or telling stories for a better tomorrow

Alignment - Making sure your visual and audio elements match the theme and tone of your film.

Originality - Coming up with a unique and powerful view

Engaging - Leave a lasting impression.



TIPS

So, you've got this awesome film project brewing, right? You're ready to dive into the world of filmmaking, but hold up – have you thought about the legal stuff? f you're using stuff that isn't yours – like someone else's tunes or epic drone shots – you need permission. Yep, that's right. Written permission.

Use the release form at the end of the Toolkit. It's your golden ticket to getting the thumbs up from your actors, location owners, musicians, and anyone else whose work is starring in your film.

You can snag some seriously cool royalty-free goodies from websites like bensound.com, purple-planet.com, and taketones.com. Need more visual flair? Check out Prelinger Archives, Pexels.com, and Shutterstock for stock footage and stills that'll make your film pop.

When using royalty free material, you still need a copy of the license.

Make sure you download the Creative commons license.

When it comes to music, don't be afraid to think local. Reach out to talented musicians in your community through social media. You might just stumble upon the perfect soundtrack for your film!

FAO'S

WHY DO I NEED RELEASE FORMS FOR MY TEAM, ACTORS, MUSIC, VIDEOS OR IMAGES I USE?

If you've used music, pictures, or even people without getting permission first, you could face some serious copyright issues. That means your film might have to be taken down, and you could even get into legal trouble. It's crucial to get the green light from everyone you include in your film and make sure you have permission for any material you use.

DOES MY FILM HAVE TO HAVE BEEN MADE THIS YEAR?

No! Any film you have made will count, as long as it fits the other criteria.

DOES THE MAX. TIME LIMIT INCLUDE THE TITLES?

Yes.

CAN I CREATE MATERIAL THAT IS SHOCKING OR CONFRONTING?

Under the broadcasting standards guidelines we need to be very careful about this. Avoid explicit scenes and obscene language - chat to us if you need some guidance.

WHAT DOES "STORIES FOR A BETTER TOMORROW" MEAN?

A "story for a better tomorrow" is a style of filmmaking that encourages viewers to contemplate ways to improve the world. These films address important topics like fairness, environmental stewardship, and community support. They aim not only to entertain but also to provoke deep thought and emotion, inspiring viewers to take action for positive change. Through these stories, viewers envision themselves as agents of change, believing in the possibility of a better world and their role in creating it.
