Civilitate takes its root from the “Lettres de Civilité” drawn by Robert Granjon, a french designer and printer. Keeping in my mind the wilderness of the originals shapes, the overall designed has been harmonised and regularised in addition to new shapes taking place in the overall set. At some point, the design became driven by the need of finding more modern directions. A majority of letters possess an initial, medial and final shape which produces a more eclectic rhythm.

This version 0.2 is bringing two new masters that shake the conception of the original intent. Starting at a very thin stage, the hairline weight is embracing the movements in a monolinear way. Closer to the first version, which was a medium weight, the black one is getting a lot more contrast and tight spacing. These two new additions expand the vision of what a Civilité letter can be.





Civiltate is a pretty open interpretation of the *Caractères de Civilité* cut by Robert Granjon. The overall gray of the text has been followed quite faithfully. However, due to the objective of modernizing the shapes, some letters have been redrawn or even drawn from scratch. The goal is not to follow precisely the original shapes as a revival would do. Understanding the system and applying the different visual systems were the goals of this first version.






