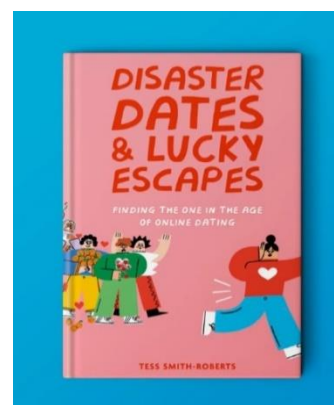

Above: Some of our 2024 'Book of the Month' selections, featuring illustrators Kingsley Nebechi, Matthew Hodson and Tess Smith Roberts

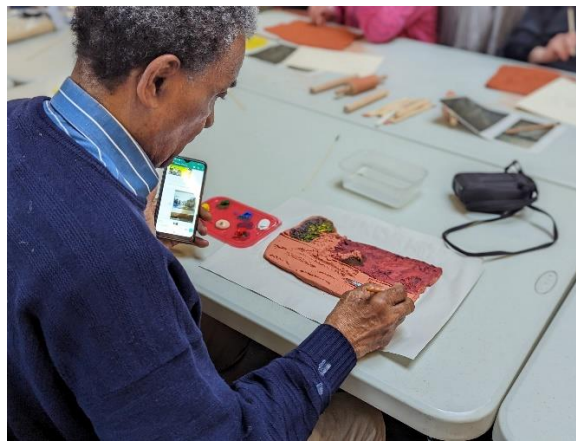
