Angel Central is served by numerous bus links which run along Upper Street and Liverpool Road. Bus routes are: 4, 19, 30, 38, 43, 56, 73, 153, 214, 274, 341, 394.

We encourage the use of public transport, but if you would like to drive there are 27 parking spaces at Angel Central, including those set aside for disabled drivers and electric vehicle charging. There is no reservation system and availability is on a first come first served basis. The car park is situated in Parkfield Street, just off Upper Street and is accessed via Berners Road, which runs along the side of the Business Design Centre.
