

Martin Listabarth – Biography

Martin Listabarth was born in Vienna in 1991. He first received classical piano lessons at the age of five and was particularly interested in improvising and composing from the beginning. Listabarth studied both jazz piano and classical piano at the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna.

In 2019, he released his debut solo album, "Short Stories." His performances have already taken him to some of the best-known venues in Austria (Wiener Musikverein, Jazzclub Porgy & Bess, ORF Radiokulturhaus), as well as Germany (Bayerisches Jazzweekend), Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland (International Jazz Piano Festival Kalisz), Romania (Jazzunique Festival) and Bulgaria (Haskovo Jazz Festival).

With his album "Dedicated", released in 2022, he convinced not only national dailies (Die Presse, Der Standard, Wiener Zeitung), but also international media, such as the British Pianist Magazine and was introduced to a wider audience by radio stations such as Ö1 and BR-Klassik.

For the years 2023/24 Martin Listabarth was selected for the funding program NASOM (The New Austrian Sound of Music) of the Austrian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
