## Dear Clients and Other Friends:

Last year our ZGuide heralded the expansion of legal markets across the globe, citing the most pro-business economy in over a half century-although we were quick to note that the business environment for 2020 looked less certain.
Big Law sailed through the first quarter of this year with the wind at its back. Demand was strong. M\&A was hot. Private equity had plenty of dry powder. The stock market was hitting record highs. Unemployment was at record lows. On New Year's Day, a virus named COVID-19 was half a world away.
By the end of the first quarter, things had changed. The virus had become a pandemic. New York's Governor Cuomo had declared a state of emergency; the NYSE had gone remote, as had nearly all of Big Law and the rest of NYC, which was soon followed by the rest of the country-save the $\sim 10 \%$ who were unemployed. By August 1st, 4,750,000 Americans had been infected; 157,000 had died, and more than 1,000 additional Americans were dying every day from the virus.
And that's only half the story. On May 25th, George Floyd was murdered by a white Minneapolis police officer. The officer had his hands in his pockets throughout the murder. He used his knee to pin Floyd's neck to the ground. Onlookers videotaping the murder with their cellphone cameras pleaded with the officer to let Floyd breathe. Staring into the cameras, the officer ignored them. Floyd didn't get another breath, but his death and the ensuing spate of deaths of more Black Americans at the hands of police officers and vigilantes filled the lungs of tens of thousands of Black Lives Matter protestors across the U.S. and western Europe, giving life to a movement for racial justice unlike anything since the Freedom Riders and the civil rights movement of the early 1960s.

At the time this foreword is being written, Big Law is about to head into budget season. Many law firms are having a good year and some even a better one than last. Most, though, are suffering modest to steep drops in revenue. The consensus view is that the downturn will stretch well into 2021, with the depth and duration likely tied to the life of the pandemic. The planning environment is a Rubik's cube. Nonetheless, we are certain one truth is already emerging: Iongstanding trends in Big Law generally will be greatly accelerated. Among them:

- Working remotely is now pervasive and increasingly accepted, something nobody would have predicted at the outset of the year. Although it will likely subside some as needs dictate and the benefits of face-to-face meetings and hallway discussions can be enjoyed in the post-pandemic era, material numbers of people will continue to work remotely for material portions of their career.
- With more remote work, workforce wellness will be front and center. Firm leaders will have to be more communicative, and personal touchpoints from leaders at all levels of the firm will have to be increased and made meaningful. Leaders must capitalize on the latest interactive technologies to establish new communications channels that instill confidence in all lawyers in all of a firm's offices that it is safe and valued for them to raise concerns. Firms will also need to find ways to foster the professional development of associates, evaluate the performance of lawyers and provide them with timely career feedback. All of this will be time-intensive and in many ways will redefine leadership roles and the skills needed to fulfill them.
- Less office space will be needed; more hoteling will take place; and some people will be moved from expensive downtown offices to less expensive space elsewhere. This will be particularly true for staff. Firms able to get ahead of this curve in ways that preserve the professional stature of personnel moved to satellite offices will enjoy a financial advantage.
- Investments in tech that paid off big time when the need to work remotely kicked in will grow as the need for better interactive meetings, training, and collaboration software and platforms grow. Already trials and mediations are proceeding virtually in some jurisdictions, and more and more, legal services are being delivered through apps. Tech is increasingly Big Law's biggest driver. Data will be quick on its heels, multiplying and accelerating the benefits of consolidation.
- In response to the groundswell of support for the Black Lives Matter movement, Big Law is making renewed and stronger efforts to draw more diverse people into its ranks, particularly
black and brown people, to train and retain them, and to move them up into their partnerships. Righting Big Law's failures in recruiting, training and promoting people of color has become an increasingly urgent moral imperative.

What remains less certain is the future of bilateralism $\nabla$. globalism; how reparable is the trading relationship between the world's two largest economies? The U.S. Presidential election looms. Will a President Trump drive a final nail in the coffin of globalism, or will a President Biden make an historic trip to Beijing on the one hand and try to stitch the Trans-Pacific Partnership back together on the other hand? To straddle the economic high-wire Big Law finds itself on, we look back to the basic principles we set forth in last year's ZGuide and in the early stages of the pandemic this year:

- Firms ought first to be engaged in scenario planning: a best, worst, and most likely case for 2021 should be top priorities. Based on our experience, many firms would benefit from taking their worst-case scenario and doubling it to form one end of the spectrum of potential outcomes.
- A shared vision of success throttled by a high-performance culture is the greatest driver of market leadership. Be proactive in ratcheting up the average level of performance by raising expectations and graciously weeding out underperformers. This makes firm platforms more magnetic for top performers and creates a flywheel effect coming out of the downturn.
- Grow muscle in your market-leading, high-rate practices. Think of markets as geographies, practice areas, and sectors. Diptychs (e.g., energy in Houston) and triptychs (e.g., life sciences private equity in Boston) breed success.
- Ease out of low-rate markets. Although we advised doing this with alacrity in last year's ZGuide, it is never too late.
- Be poised to move on lateral talent. It is already on the move. Vet more carefully than ever. Prioritize pursuits of people and teams identified and vouched for by your high performers and strategically important clients; avoid unconditional guarantees.
- Don't skip a rate increase. Instead, defer rate increases for good clients in need of relief and, when you defer, get a share of the upside on results.
- Emphasize disciplined client and engagement intake and management coupled strongly with proactive pricing and practice management to produce high margins. Enhance your data analytics so that you have a firm grasp on the types of work and the practice areas within your firm that earn the highest returns.
- Check in with clients to ensure they perceive that your pricing is aligned with the value you are delivering. Put a marker down throughout the firm: service drives the perception of value.
- Manage to your high performers at all levels in the firm. These are the people that go down the elevator every day with options. Make sure they want to come up with their team the next morning. Stay close to your top and up-and-coming performers; make sure they have the resources they need to keep building and strengthen the platform.

We once again find ourselves evermore grateful to you, our clients, the many Am Law 200 and Global 200 and China 45 firms that participate in our Chair, COO, and CMO Roundtables, and to our many other friends in the industry for their interest in and enduring support of our work. And we truly appreciate the $\sim 100$ law firm chairs and managing partners and the numerous COOs and CMOs who have participated in our COVID-19 Flash Surveys and Zoom calls since the onset of the pandemic.
More than ever, we underscore our gratitude for your extraordinary contributions of time and money to pro bono representations and to the communities that depend on them around the globe. We are inspired by and join all of them in the belief that these contributions are cornerstones of the success and strength of the rule of law and the legal system we serve and cherish. And we ask not whether, but how, we can do more to support your efforts.

We look forward to our continued work with you on these important endeavors.

## Methodology


#### Abstract

The Am Law 200 is reported by ALM journalists and researchers. Most law firms provide their financials voluntarily for this report, but all data, whether it comes officially from the firm or not, is investigated by reporters.


## Definitions

Gross Revenue is fee income from legal work. It does not include disbursements or income from nonlegal ancillary businesses. Net operating income is total compensation paid to equity partners.

Equity partners are those who receive no more than half their compensation on a fixed-income basis. Nonequity partners are those who receive more than half their compensation on a fixed-income basis. Retired partners and of counsel are not counted as partners, nor are payments made to them included in net operating income.

Lawyer numbers are average full-time-equivalent figures for the 2019 calendar year. Temp and contract attorneys are not included.

## Calculations

- Gross Revenue is rounded to the nearest $\$ 500,000$.
- Profits Per Equity Partner, Revenue Per Lawyer, and Compensation Average All Partners are rounded to the nearest $\$ 5,000$.
- Profits Per Equity Partner (PDEP) is the net operating income divided by the number of equity partners.
- Revenue Per Lawyer (RPL) is the gross revenue divided by the total number of lawyers, measured on a FTE basis.
- Compensation Average All Partners is the net operating income plus the fixed-income compensation paid to nonequity partners, divided by the total number of partners, both equity and nonequity.
- Value Per Lawyer (VPL) is the compensation averaģe all partners divided by the total number of lawyers. That number is then divided into $\$ 10$ million to determine how many lawyers it takes to generate that amount.


## Location of Firms

Some firms are identified as "International" or "National," rather than identifying them by city, according to the distribution of their lawyers. International firms are those with 40 percent or more of their lawyers outside the United States. National firms are those with no more than 45 percent of their lawyers located in any single region of the U.S.

Vereins are broken out separately on the charts because their organizational structure, particularly regarding profit sharing among offices, differs significantly from traditionally structured Am Law firms.

## The A-List

The A-List, comprised of just 20 firms, is determined by rankings in five categories - pro bono, revenue per lawyer, associate satisfaction, racial diversity, and the percentage of female equity partners. Scores for revenue per lawyer and pro bono are weighted twice in calculating the overall score, which is the basis of the rankings. ## Methodology

The Global Charts were produced by ALM Legal Intelligence with reporting by The American Lawyer and other ALM publications. The Global 100 and the China 45 appeared in the October 2019 issue of The American Lawyer; the Global 200 and the Asia 50 appeared in the November issue. A total of 240 firms were included on the Global 200 charts, but the ZGuide includes only the top 200 ranked by gross revenue, and the top 100 of those firms ranked by profits per equity partner. Although foreign law firms differ in structure from U.S. law firms, steps were taken in the research process to level the playing field. Currency conversion rates to U.S. dollars are annual averages for 2018.

The Global 100 chart (page 36) ranks the world's 100 largest Iaw firms by profits per equity partner and includes data on revenue and rankings based on the number of lawyers in a firm and the number of countries in which a firm has offices.

The Global 200 chart (page 46) ranks the world's 200 largest law firms by gross revenue and includes data and rankings, where available, for each firm's profits per equity partner, revenue per lawyer, number of countries in which the firm has offices, and number of lawyers and equity partners.

The China 45 chart (page 66) ranks the largest firms in China by profits per equity partner and includes data on gross revenue and revenue per lawyer.

The Asia 50 chart (page 72) ranks the largest firms in the Asia Pacific region by the number of lawyers in that region and includes the country in which the firm has the most lawyers.

## Profits Per Equity Partner (PPEP)

PPEP figures were obtained from the same sources that provided the revenue figures and rounded to the nearest $\$ 1,000$. Only the Global 100 were ranked by PPEP in The American Lawyer's report. PPEP figures for other U.S. firms on the Global 200 chart are from the 2019 Am Law 200.

## Gross Revenue

The firms ranked by Gross Revenue were determined by ALM to be the world's 200 highest-grossing law firms. In most cases, gross revenues for U.S. firms were derived from the Am Law 200, while other firms were surveyed directly for The American Lawyer's Global 200, Legal Week's U.K. Top 100, or The American Lawyer's Asia/China report. Gross revenue and revenue per lawyer figures were rounded to the nearest $\$ 1,000$.

## Number of Lawyers

Rankings are based on the average number of full-time equivalent lawyers at the firm in the previous calendar year. For U.K. firms, the number of lawyers is based on the fiscal year ending April 30. Firms that are ranked were determined by ALM to be the world's largest firms.

## Most Countries

The ranking in the last column of the Global 100 chart is based on the number of countries in which a firm has offices.

## Location of Firms

On the Global 100 and Global 200 charts, the country listed is the country where the firm had the highest percentage of lawyers. On the China 45 chart, the location is the city listed on the firm's web site as the firm's main office.

## Whe Corporate Scorecard

## Methodology

The Corporate Scorecard was published by The American Lawyer in April 2020. The rankings were developed in collaboration with, and culled by, a number of third-party sources and gathered by ALM Legal Intelligence. The Corporate Scorecard details the performance of law firms with the most active corporate finance and capital markets practices in 2019. Unless otherwise noted, data includes only public, registered, underwritten offerings or deals transacted in the previous calendar year, including firmly underwritten Rule 144a transactions, but not pure private placements or the filing of shelf registrations. Rankings are based on data reported as of February of 2020. Unless otherwise noted, the source for the Corporate Scorecard data is Refinitiv, formerly the Financial and Risk business of Thomson Reuters.

Mergers and Acquisitions and Buyouts data includes deals with a North American-based target that were announced but not necessarily completed in 2019, and were valued at $\$ 100$ million or more, including debt. Only counsel to bidders that billed more than $\$ 100,000$ are given credit. In some cases, a firm's involvement is prorated, depending on its role, and the firm is given partial credit. Source: Mergermarket

IPOs include offerings by U.S. and non-U.S. corporations in the U.S. marketplace.

Equities include worldwide issues by U.S. corporations and non-U.S. corporations, including secondaries, convertible bonds, and convertible and nonconvertible preferred stock. It excludes asset-backed securities and REITs.

Corporate Debt includes both investment-grade and highyield securities. Investment-grade debt includes securities with a Standard \& Poor's rating equal to or greater than BBB- and a Moody's rating equal to or greater than Baa3, and split junk-rated securities. High-yield debt includes securities with an S\&P rating equal to or less than BB+ and a Moody's rating equal to or less than Ba1, but excludes split junk-rated securities. Securities not rated by either agency are assumed to be high yield. Both areas exclude certificate of deposit, general term notes, and issues by federal credit agencies, sovereigns, and national governments.

Asset- and Mortgage-Backed Securities are counted as a single offering when multiple classes of securities are issued together with one legal adviser. Separate Iegal advisers are credited with the separate securities they handled. Mortgage-backed securities include commercial and residential offerings.

Municipal Bonds data is based on new long-term municipal issues. Short-term, preliminary, and private placement issues are not included.

REITs data includes equities and debt offerings by real estate investment trusts.

Project Finance data is based on deals signed and funded in 2019 and includes only non-recourse and limited recourse facilities. Firms are credited for advising borrowers, concession awarders, commercial lenders, multilateral lenders, export credit agencies, guarantors, and divestors. Source: Dealogic
